<b>Line 10</b>	<b>Operates on Coleman Ave. and Airport Boulevard</b> , but no longer serves De La Cruz or the airport employee parking lots.	<b>Community Bus Line 34</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Weekdays between the San Antonio Transit Center and downtown Mountain View.</b> Service along Sylvan and Grant to El Camino Hospital discontinued. Saturday Service discontinued.	<b>Line 51</b>	<b>Between Akron &amp; McCord in Moffett Field and De Anza College.</b> Additional peak hour service between Akron & McCord and Truman & Bryant. Service on Homestead to Cupertino Square, weekday peak hour service to Parsons & Allen at NASA/Ames and Saturday service discontinued.

<b>Line 12</b>	<b>Minor routing change between Civic Center and the Flea Market</b> to align with proposed Lines 61 and 62.	<b>Line 36</b>	<b>Discontinued</b> , but Lines 61 & 62 replace some service east of North First Street.	<b>Line 54</b>	<b>Between De Anza College and the Lockheed Martin Transit Center.</b> De Anza College to West Valley College replaced with Line 53 service. Service through Garner, Bradford and Persian to Fair Oaks & Tasman, and weekday peak hour service on Java, discontinued.
<b>Line 22</b>	<b>Service to Menlo Park discontinued</b> – all buses to start and end at the Palo Alto Transit Center.	<b>Community Bus Line 37</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Route extended to West Valley College</b> via Camden, Winchester to the Winchester Light Rail Station, Hacienda, Burrows, Pollard, Quito and Allendale. No Saturday service.	<b>Line 55</b>	<b>Service no longer provided to Sandia, Fairwood and Palamos on selected northbound trips.</b>
<b>Line 23</b>	<b>From De Anza College to Alum Rock Transit Center.</b> Service between Foothill College and the San Antonio Transit Center replaced by a modified Line 40. Service from Mountain View and Los Altos to De Anza College replaced by a modified Line 51.	<b>Line 38</b>	<b>Discontinued.</b>	<b>Line 58</b>	<b>Maintain weekday peak hour service.</b> Routing in Alviso to operate only on First, Taylor, Gold, Catherine and Liberty.
<b>Line 25</b>	<b>Service to East Hills and Meadow discontinued</b> - all buses remain on Story, White and Alum Rock.	<b>Community Bus Line 39</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Route modified to operate between Eastridge and The Villages</b> via Quimby, Murillo, Aborn, Ruby, Classico, Fowler, San Felipe to the Villages.	<b>Line 59</b>	<b>Discontinued.</b>
<b>Line 26</b>	<b>Extra service between Eastridge and Curtner Light Rail Station on weekdays.</b> Weekday service to Wolfe & Arques maintained. Weekend service to downtown Sunnyvale discontinued.	<b>Line 40</b>	<b>Route extended to serve Foothill College via San Antonio and El Monte.</b> Sunday service would turn around in downtown Los Altos.	<b>Line 60</b>	<b>Terminate at the Winchester Transit Center</b> and no longer operate to Winchester & Knowles. Additional late service to Winchester & Knowles will be provided by Line 48.
<b>Line 27</b>	<b>Terminates at Good Samaritan Hospital.</b> Line 37 will replace some of old routing.	<b>Community Bus Line 42</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Between Monterey &amp; Senter and the Santa Teresa Light Rail Station</b> including the East Branham, Ford/Silverleaf areas and VA Clinic on San Ignacio.	<b>Lines 61</b>	<b>Between Good Samaritan Hospital and Sierra &amp; Piedmont</b> via Bascom, Naglee, Taylor, Coleman, Hedding, 1st, Taylor, Mabury, Capitol, Berryessa and Piedmont to Sierra. Much of the routing east of Civic Center replaces former Line 36 and Line 59 service.
<b>Line 31</b>	<b>Eastridge to Evergreen Valley College.</b> Line 39 will serve the Villages.	<b>Line 43</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Between Eastridge and the Alum Rock Transit Center</b> via Capitol Expressway on Sundays.	<b>Line 62</b>	<b>Between Good Samaritan Hospital and Sierra &amp; Piedmont</b> via Union, Bascom, Naglee, Taylor, Coleman, Hedding, 1st, Taylor, 10th/11th, Hedding, Berryessa, Capitol and Sierra to Piedmont.
<b>Community Bus Line 32</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Moderate routing changes</b> between Middlefield & Ellis and the Sunnyvale Transit Center, and between Monroe & Bowers and the Santa Clara Transit Center.	<b>Community Bus Line 45</b> <b>NEW</b>	<b>Between the Alum Rock Transit Center and the Penitencia Creek Transit Center.</b>		
<b>Line 33</b>	<b>Retains current routing between Great Mall and McCarthy Ranch.</b> Service along Zanker and to 1st & Tasman discontinued.	<b>Line 47</b>	<b>Modified near Milpitas High School to loop on Arizona instead of Milpitas Blvd.</b>		

- Line 63** Between downtown San Jose and Almaden Expwy and Camden. Service no longer provided to Almaden & Via Valiente.
- Line 64** Between the Almaden Light Rail Station and McKee & White. East of the San Jose Diridon Station, operates on Cahill, San Fernando through downtown San Jose out to McKee.
- Community Bus Line 65** Blossom Hill & Meridian to downtown San Jose via Blossom Hill, Camden, Leigh, Moorpark/Parkmoor, Lincoln, San Carlos, Montgomery/Autumn, San Jose Diridon Station, San Fernando, 1st/2nd to Bassett. Saturday & Sunday service discontinued.
- Line 67** Discontinued.
- Line 70** The routing would remain on Adrian in both directions between Alfred and Ocala.
- Line 72** Downtown San Jose and Monterey & Senter. Buses

would turn around at Monterey & Branham. South of Monterey & Senter service provided by the new Line 42.

- Line 76** Maintain current service but operate only on days when Los Gatos High School is in session. No Summer service.
- Line 77** Weekday peak hour service between the Great Mall and Milpitas & Calaveras would be discontinued.
- Line 81** Between Cupertino Square and San Jose State University. Between Park & Meridian and downtown San Jose the route operates on Meridian, San Carlos, Almaden Blvd, San Fernando and turn around via 6th, Santa Clara and 7th. Service no longer provided on Park between Meridian and Almaden Blvd. Service from downtown San Jose to McKee & White provided by Line 64.

- Line 82** Between Westgate and the Bassett Terminal in downtown San Jose. Service along 7th St. discontinued, and some service north of downtown San Jose provided by new Line 11.
- Line 85** Discontinued
- Community Bus Line 88** **NEW** Between the Palo Alto Veteran's Hospital and the San Antonio Transit Center via Charleston and Fabian. Extended morning and afternoon trips on school days for Gunn High School to Louis Rd. The routing on Louis, Channing, Homer, Middlefield and Lytton to the Palo Alto Transit Center and Saturday service discontinued.
- Community Bus Line 89** Weekday peak hours between the California Avenue Caltrain Station and the Veterans Hospital via California, Hanover, Hillview, Arastradero and Miranda.

## Express Bus Lines

- Express Line 101** Discontinued
- Express Line 103** Maintain service to Fruitdale & Southwest Expressway and a stop added at Cupertino Square to replace Express 101 service. Maintain current number of trips.
- Express Line 120** Bypass Milpitas. Maintain service and stops along Mission Blvd in Fremont. Maintain current number of trips.
- Express Line 121** Maintain current routing with additional later a.m. and p.m. trip.
- Express Line 140** Between Fremont BART and Mission College Blvd and Montague Expwy via Mission Blvd, Hwy 880, Tasman, Old Ironsides, Great America and Mission College Blvd. Maintain current number of trips.
- Express Line 168** **NEW** Between Gilroy, San Martin and Morgan Hill to downtown San Jose. Five northbound a.m. and five southbound p.m. trips, operating approximately every 30 minutes.
- Express Line 180** Weekday peak hours, between Fremont BART and Great Mall. Weekday midday and weekends, from Fremont BART to the San Jose Diridon Station. Buses would no longer stop at 1st & Younger.
- Express Line 181** **NEW** Weekday peak hours between Fremont BART and the San Jose Diridon Station, via Mission Blvd, Hwy 680, Mission Blvd, Hwy. 880, 1st & 2nd Streets, and San Fernando to San Jose Diridon Station.

No changes from current service levels or routing are proposed for these lines: 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 52, 102, 104, 122, 182, 328, 330, 522.

Service frequency changes are proposed for the following lines: 46, 57, 66, 68, 71, 73.

- Limited Stop 304** Between South San Jose and Sunnyvale Transit Center, operates on De La Cruz, Central Expressway, Scott, Arques, Central Expressway to Mathilda and ends at the Sunnyvale Transit Center instead of downtown Mountain View.
- Limited Stop 305** Discontinued.
- Limited Stop 321** Maintain 1 trip in each direction.
