# ***Tasman East Light Rail Project***

---

## **Overview**

The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) currently operates two light rail lines in Santa Clara County. The Mountain View to Winchester Line serves Mountain View, Sunnyvale, Santa Clara, San Jose and Campbell. The Alum Rock to Santa Teresa Line, which includes the Tasman East Light Rail Extension, serves San Jose and Milpitas.

The Tasman Light Rail Extension was initially planned as a 12.4-mile expansion of the existing line. However, funding constraints resulted in a phased construction beginning with the Tasman West 7.6 mile segment to Downtown Mountain View (Completed December 20, 1999).

VTA works closely with local jurisdictions on region-wide strategies to address traffic congestion, gridlock and air quality concerns, and this project is an important part of these efforts.

## **Project Features**

### **Phase 1: North First Street to I-880**

Length: 1.9 miles in the median of Tasman Drive

Stations: Baypointe, Cisco Way Station and I-880/Milpitas Station.

Parking: 280 spaces at the I-880/Milpitas Station

### **Phase 2: I-880 to Hostetter**

Length: 3.0 miles in the median of Great Mall Parkway and Capitol Avenue, including approximately 7,200 ft. bridge structure to provide grade separation from two freight railroads, Montague Expressway, and other cross streets.

Stations: Great Mall/Main, Montague, Cropley and Hostetter

Parking: 95 dedicated and 50 shared parking spaces at the Great Mall/Main Transit Center and 100 spaces at the Hostetter Station.

## **Disabled Access**

The light rail extension is fully accessible in accordance with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

---

## **Operations**

Projected weekday ridership on the Tasman East segment in the year 2015 is 2,550 riders.

---

## **Capital Cost/ Project Funding**

Total Project Cost: \$272.8 million (Measure B: \$72.5 million, non-Measure B contributions include Federal/State at \$99.0 million, Milpitas at \$1.1 million for Montague widening, San Jose at \$0.5 million for pavement restoration, VTA bond revenues from fund swap at \$100.0 million).

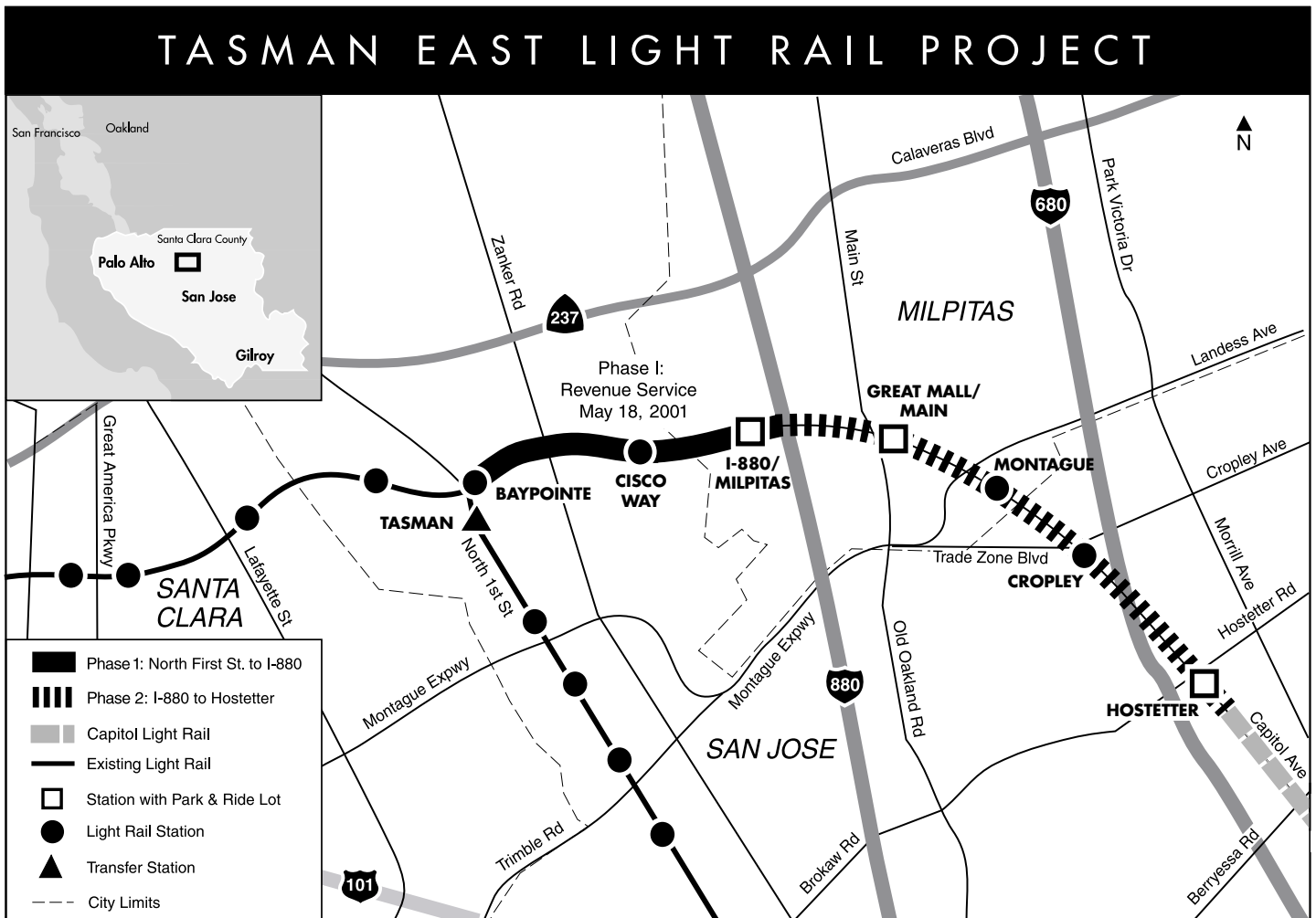
## Project Schedule

**Phase 1:** Baypointe Station opened with the Tasman West Project in December 1999.  
Service to the I-880/Milpitas Station opened May 18, 2001.

**Phase 2:** The project opened for revenue service on June 24, 2004.
