# Vasona Light Rail Project

---

## **Project Overview**

Vasona Light Rail Project is a 5.3-mile extension to the existing 36.9-mile VTA light rail system. The project will be built in two phases adding 8 new stations between Woz Way in downtown San Jose and Winchester in Campbell. Vasona Light Rail will operate primarily on the existing Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way between the San Jose Diridon Station and Vasona Junction, with the segment between the San Fernando and San Jose Diridon Stations operating within a tunnel alignment.

## **Project Features**

### **Phase 1 – Downtown San Jose to Winchester Station in Campbell**

- Length: 5.3 miles
- Stations: San Fernando, San Jose Diridon, Race, Fruitdale, Bascom, Hamilton, Downtown Campbell, and Winchester. A future station is proposed at West San Carlos Street in the Midtown area of San Jose
- Parking: 102 spaces at Bascom Station and 55 spaces at Winchester Station

### **Phase 2 – Winchester in Campbell to Vasona Junction in Los Gatos**

- Length: 1.5 miles
- Stations: Hacienda and Vasona Junction
- Parking: 163 to 220 spaces at Vasona Junction Station

## **Disabled Access**

The light rail extension will be fully accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

---

## **Operations**

Travel time from the Winchester Station to downtown San Jose will be approximately 16 minutes. Expected daily ridership is 8,000 to 9,000 riders.

## **Capital Cost**

<b>Phase 1:</b>	\$61.5M	in Federal funds for Vasona (Woz Way to Campbell Avenue)
	\$15.0M	State General Funds for Winchester
	\$164.7M	from 1996 Measure B local sales tax funds
	\$56.4M	VTA bond revenues from funds swapped
	\$16.5M	from Vasona tunnel VTA contribution
	\$0.6M	from City of Campbell

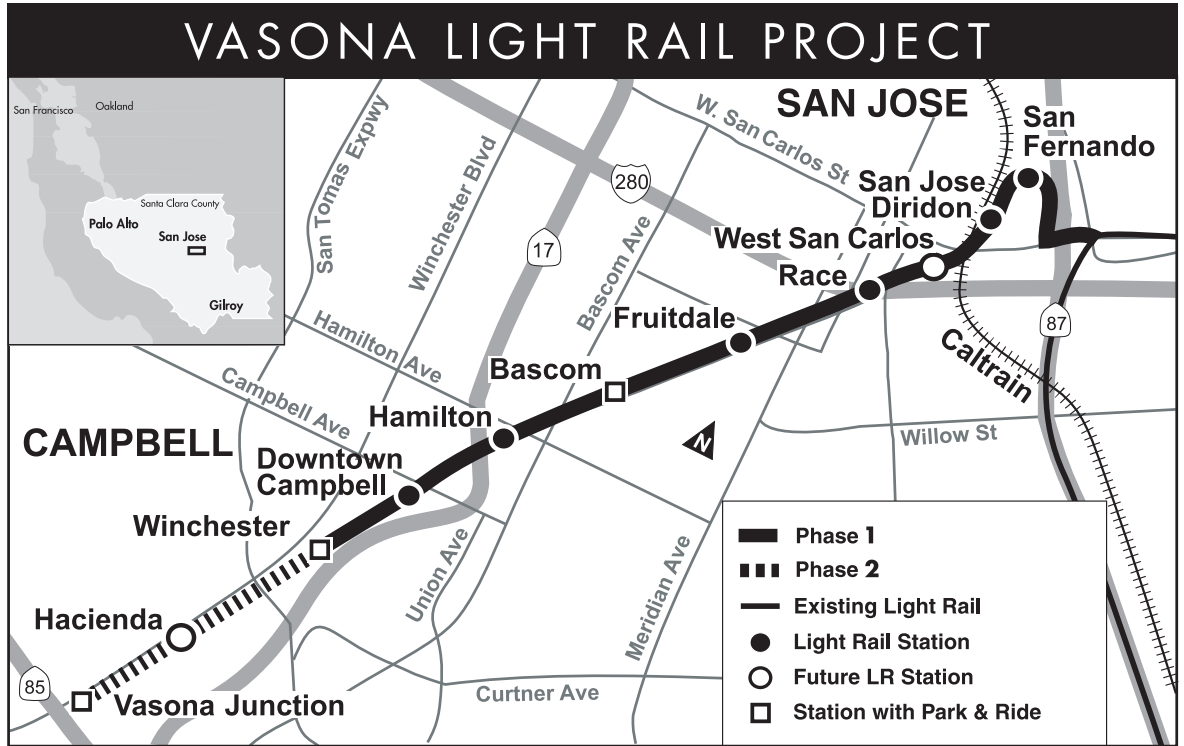
**Project Schedule and Milestones**

**Phase 2:** Schedule is dependent upon available funding.

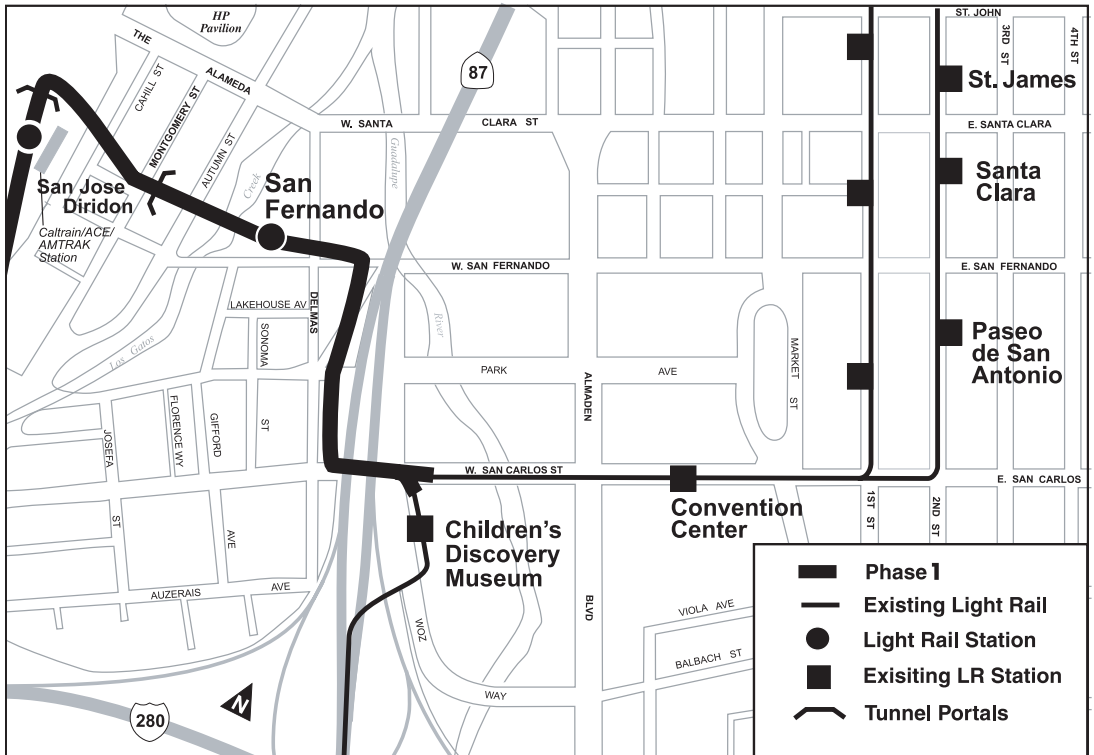
