



VTA Construction Notice EFFECTIVE September 10, 2009

What: Crews will be retrofitting the area along the retaining walls and track at the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) Hamilton Light Rail Station to improve the durability and the seismic resistance of the walls and tracks.

When: Weekdays from Thursday, September 10 through October 30; 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Weekend work will occur on Saturday, September 26 through Sunday, September 27, and on Saturday, October 3 through Sunday, October 4 (if needed); 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Where: Hamilton light rail station

Notes: Minor equipment noise from hammer drill, small saw, tile/paver saw, and generator. There will also be back-up sensors (back-up beepers) from larger equipment.

VTA Light Rail Service will be suspended at the Winchester, Campbell, and Hamilton light rail stations while the work is taking place during the two weekends scheduled. There will be a free VTA bus bridge available for passengers traveling between the Winchester, Campbell, and Hamilton light rail stations. Please note that the light rail schedule will not mirror the bus bridge schedule because the buses must go with the flow of current traffic conditions.
