Notes: Operators will observe all coach stops along reroute. Operators will observe all stop requests when safe

LINE 25 EASTBOUND: From Tamien Station buses will turn Left on Lelong, Left on Alma, Left on Almaden, Right on Willow to Regular Route.

LINE 25 WEST BOUND: From Willow, buses will turn Left on Vine, Right on Alma, Right on Lelong, Right on Into Tamien Station to regular Route.
