What: Reroute

When: 9:00 a.m. Monday 10/26 to 6:30 p.m. Friday 10/30

City: Los Gatos

Why: Construction

Street Closures: Winchester, between Lark and 85

Routes Effected: Line 48

Notes: Operators will observe all coach stops along reroute. Operators will observe all stop requests when safe

LINE 48 NORTHBOUND: From Winchester, Right on Lark, Left on Hwy. 17 on-ramp N/B, Right on Camden off-ramp, Left on Camden, onto San Tomas, Right on Winchester off-ramp S/B, Right on Knowles, Right on Pollard, Right on Burrows to regular route.

LINE 48 SOUTHBOUND: From Burrows, Left on Pollard, Left on Knowles, Left on Winchester, Right on Camden on-ramp (To Hwy. 17), Right on Hwy. 17 on-ramp S/B, Right on Lark off-ramp, Right on Lark, Left on Winchester to regular route.
