



**VTA CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY
BUS STOP IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 2011 THROUGH FEBRUARY 2012**

The following will be in effect as indicated, weather and conditions permitting.

WHAT: Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) plans to upgrade bus stops, surrounding sidewalks and streets beginning October 2011 through February 2012: Upgrades to sidewalks, driveways, and pavement will provide better access for VTA customers. Due to the construction, the above bus stops will be temporarily relocated. Temporary bus stops may be placed close to the original stop but safely away from the actual construction site. The work will take place during the day at each location. Overall, it will take approximately two days to two weeks to complete each site, depending upon the proposed scope of work for each stop.

WHEN: October 2011 through February 2012

WHERE: Improvements will be made at the following locations:

North Bowers Avenue near El Camino Real
North Bowers Ave near Monroe Street
South De La Cruz Boulevard near Clyde Ave
North De La Cruz Blvd at Montague Expy

City of San José

South Miller Avenue near Bollinger Road
West Williams Road near Winchester Blvd.
East Hedding Street near Coleman Street
West San Fernando Street near 7th Street
East Julian Street near 13th Street
East Julian Street near 17th Street
South Capitol Ave near Alum Rock Road
North Senter Road near Singleton Road
North Adrian Drive near Amador Drive
South Murillo Ave near Quimby Road
South Murillo Ave near Chemin De Riviere
