



27 BUS STOPS TO RECEIVE UPGRADES IN EAST SAN JOSE AND MILPITAS EFFECTIVE April 19, 2010

The following bus stop upgrades will be in effect as indicated, weather and conditions permitting.

VTA Bus Stop Improvements Program	
LOCATION	San Jose and Milpitas, CA
SITE	26 bus stops along King Road in East San Jose and one bus stop on Landess Avenue at Park Victoria Drive in Milpitas.
WHAT	Crews will be upgrading surrounding sidewalks, streets, and pavement.
WHEN	During the day
DATE	Monday, April 19, through June 2010.
ACTIVITY	Limited noise from equipment and trucks will occur during daytime hours only, adhering to local noise ordinance. Some lane closures may occur where necessary.
DETOUR	Temporary bus stops will be relocated close to the original bus stops.
TRAFFIC CONTROLS	For the safety of the public and workers, flag personnel may be present where necessary.
