

VTA CONSTRUCTION UPDATE SOUTH COUNTY CALTRAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT November 2, 2009

The following will be in effect as indicated, weather and conditions permitting.

WHAT: Crews will relocate fiber optic cable along the railway corridor from Blanchard Road in south San Jose to Tilton Avenue in Morgan Hill.



WHERE: The Construction activities will occur in the Union Pacific Rail Road right-of-way and various intersections from Blanchard Road to Tilton Avenue.

WHEN: Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. (Nov. 2009 through April 2010)

WHY: To increase Caltrain service capacity and improve safety by constructing a second set of new railway track and various road and railway crossing improvements, including relocation of fiber optic cables, grading and retaining wall construction.

NOTES: Current activities are not expected to impact the surrounding communities or traffic except for construction vehicles entering and exiting the construction site. For the safety of the public and construction workers, traffic control measures will be used when needed. Informational and warning signs will be posted as necessary to ensure everyone's safety. Construction crews will make every effort to maintain access and minimize inconvenience to motorists.
