LINE 22 WESTBOUND: Regular route on Santa Clara St. (will not observe usual Friday night re-route)

LINE 22 EASTBOUND: Regular route on Santa Clara St. (will not observe usual Friday night re-route)

LINE 23 WESTBOUND: From 2nd & Santa Clara, Right on San Fernando, Right on First, Left on Santa Clara, Left on Montgomery, Right on San Carlos to regular route.

LINE 23 EASTBOUND: From San Carlos, Left on Montgomery, onto Autumn, Right on Santa Clara to regular route.

LINE 64 NORTHBOUND: From Diridon Transit Center, Left on Cahill, Right on Santa Clara, Left on 13th St to regular route.

LINE 64 SOUTHBOUND: From Santa Clara, Left on Cahill to regular route.

LINE 180 NORTHBOUND: From Diridon Transit Center, Left on San Fernando, Left on Autumn, Right on Santa Clara, Left on First St to regular route.

LINE 180 SOUTHBOUND: From 2nd & Santa Clara, Right on San Fernando, Right on First, Left on Santa Clara, Left on Cahill to Diridon Transit Center.
