

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

KATO FLOOD CONTROL IMPROVEMENTS

WHAT: Drainage and flood improvement construction will continue on the west end of Castilleja development (with a portion extending east along Kato Road in residential landscaping area) and in Scott Creek near the railroad tracks.

In addition, along the Castilleja residential development and the most northern portion of the Montebello development (along the railroad tracks) the existing sound wall will be removed and replaced with a higher sound wall in 250 foot sections.

Removal and replacement of landscaping will also occur along Kato Road.

WHEN: Continuing September through December
Monday through Saturday (*Typical*); 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Scheduled Heightened Activity:

Friday, September 11 through Monday, September 14

- Coordinated railroad shutdown, demolition of Scott Creek channel
- 72-hour continuous work period
- This activity will require NIGHT and SUNDAY WORK

GENERAL IMPACTS: Overall activities through December may include the following: pile driving (vibrating metal sheets into the ground), demolition noise, Vehicle warning beepers, dust, flood lights, idling diesel engines, and possible Sunday and night work.

WHY: This work is required to make local flood control improvements prior to a planned grade separation (see attached fact sheet). This will minimize future disruptions during grade separation construction.

PROJECT INFORMATION: This notice serves as a general update for all anticipated impacts. Sunday and night work are **not** typical activities but may occur infrequently to complete the project.
