

Valley Transportation Plan 2050

Overview

The Valley Transportation Plan 2050 (VTP 2050) is the countywide long-range transportation plan for Santa Clara County. As the County Transportation Agency (CTA) for the county, the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) periodically updates this 25-year plan.

VTP provides a planning and policy framework for developing and delivering future transportation projects. It considers all modes of travel such as: Highways, Local Streets and Roads, Expressways, Transit, Transportation Systems and Management/Intelligent Transportation Systems, and Bicycles. The Plan also identifies existing and future transportation needs through a systematic approach based on input from local jurisdictions, elected officials and the community. The VTP will provide input to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's (MTC) future Regional Transportation Planning process, known as Plan Bay Area (PBA).



Approach

The previous plan, VTP 2040, was adopted in 2014. For VTP 2050, VTA will gather meaningful feedback from the public, identify goals, set a vision for transportation, develop an equitable approach to address transportation concerns, and focus on ever-advancing climate emergency. VTA has developed a phased process that will include multiple opportunities for the public to participate in the process. The current plan update will coordinate input from VTA's Board and Committees.

Spring 2023 Draft Project Lists Development
Summer 2023 Final List of Projects
Fall/Winter 2023 Develop Draft Plan
Late 2023 VTP adopted by the Board
