



## EASTRIDGE TO BART REGIONAL CONNECTOR PROJECT PG&E UTILITY RELOCATION NOTICE

In advance of the Eastridge to BART Regional Connector Project construction, PG&E is replacing sections of their natural gas pipeline on Capitol Avenue between Bambi Lane and Story Road in San Jose. Residents and businesses located within 300 feet of areas where work is taking place can expect to receive a notice directly from PG&E.

For everyone outside the immediate work area:

- What** PG&E Utility Replacement to replace sections of natural gas pipeline (the line is about 4” diameter)
- Where** Capitol Avenue between Bambi Lane and Story Road in San Jose
- When** *Weather and conditions permitting*, beginning on or about June 6. Preliminary activities could extend this activity through July 2022. Crews will work Monday through Friday, 8:15am-4:15pm.
- Traffic** Intermittent sidewalk and driveway closures in front of homes nearest World Oil, no parking signs in work areas will be posted. Please plan for minor delays when driving through project area. Project crews are working with residents to maintain access.

**What to Expect:** *If you are located near the work area* you may experience noise from large trucks and equipment and smell a small amount of natural gas while the crew clears the line. For everyone’s safety, there may be a temporary interruption of service while PG&E connects the new line. **PG&E will notify customers if there will be an interruption and will schedule a gas relight with you at your convenience.**

Preliminary activities include 1 tree removal and 1 tree trimming.
