





Fatal or Severe Injury Collisions (5-Year Total)

Note that collisions of other levels of severity, or property damage only collisions, are not shown on these maps.




[LEFT]

This map shows the pedestrians or bicyclists killed or severely injured in those collisions.




Planned, Underway, & Recently Completed

This map illustrates projects relevant to the study area of the Community-Based Transportation Plan that are recently completed, underway, or planned.




Community Needs Summary
