**Subject:** Eastridge to BART Regional Connector Project – Notice of Recommended Award

At the March 7, 2024, Board meeting, staff will be requesting the Board of Directors authorize the award of the construction contract for the Eastridge to BART Regional Connector (EBRC) Project to MCM-Railworks, JV, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in the amount of \$437,161,464.

This memorandum is to let the Board know that a Notice of Recommended Award was issued on February 14, 2024, for the above-referenced contract. The issuance of the notice starts the five-working day period for a bidder to protest against the rejection of its bid or the award of the contract to another bidder.

As a result, when the EBRC contract is presented to the Board for consideration in March, the protest period will have expired. The protest period expires on February 22, 2024.

A planned Board workshop is scheduled for February 23, 2024, during which time, staff will be providing the project scope, contract, and budget funding for the EBRC project.

In brief, the EBRC Project is a design-bid-build\* project that was competitively procured utilizing the Invitation for Bids (IFB) method of procurement. A few highlights of the procurement are as follows:
