We understand that the Construction Transportation Management Plan (CTMP) for Early Works has been approved. Can you provide an update on the CTMP for the primary phase of construction?	We will have several CTMPs for each area of major work. The next one we are advancing is East Portal and the 28th Street/Little Portugal station area, then the Downtown and Diridon station areas combined. They are being developed as the design advances by the contractor on the means and methods. We have a graphic we can share of where all the different CTMPs will be. Specific to West Portal Major construction, the internal and contracting teams must work through details before we can coordinate with stakeholders. Developing the CTMP for that work will likely begin later this year, but we will engage you and let you know the
