



FACT SHEET: *Highways*

I-280/Winchester Boulevard Interchange Improvements Project

Overview

Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), in cooperation with the City of San Jose and California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to construct improvements in the vicinity of the Interstate 280 (I-280)/Winchester Boulevard Interchange.

Objective

The purpose of the project is to:

- Relieve congestion and improve traffic operations on the freeways and local roadways in the vicinity of the I-280/Winchester Boulevard
- Provide new access from northbound I-280 to Winchester Boulevard
- Improve bicycle, pedestrian, and transit accessibility and connectivity

Capital Cost/Project Funding

Project cost is to be determined and will depend on included improvements which are yet to be defined. The project is partially funded.

This project will be funded by a combination of VTA 2016 Measure B and local funds.

Alternatives Analysis and Preliminary Engineering:	2016 - 2017 <i>completed</i>
Environmental Approval*:	2017 - 2020
Design Completion*:	2020 - 2022
Project Construction*:	2022 - 2025

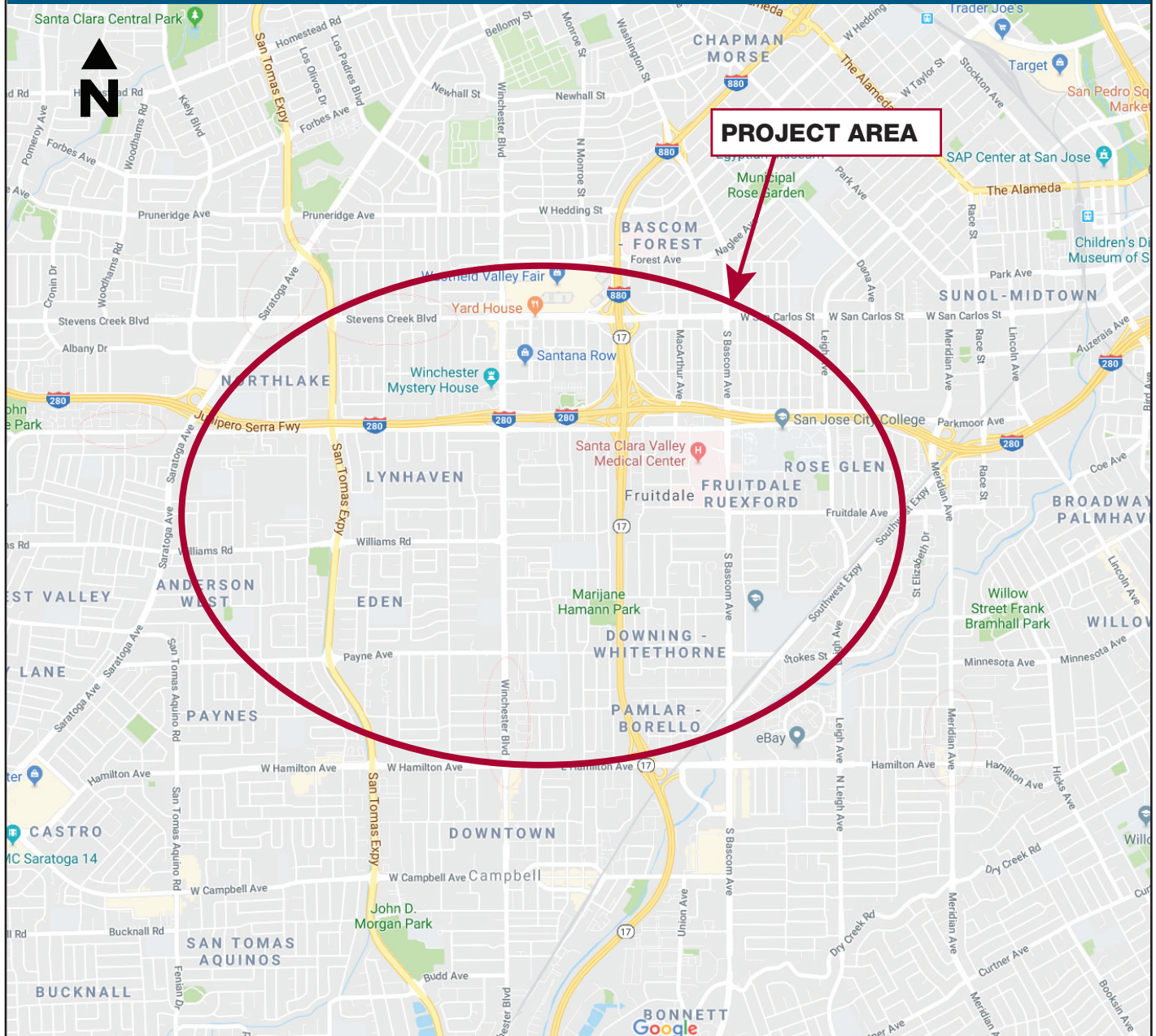
