I-680 Soundwalls Project

Overview

Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), in cooperation with California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to construct new soundwalls along I-680 between Capitol Expressway and Mueller Avenue in San Jose.

Objective

The purpose of this project is to reduce noise by constructing soundwalls as an effective noise abatement measure.

Project Features

The proposed improvements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Construct new soundwalls along northbound I-680 between Capitol Expressway and Muirfield Drive
- Construct new soundwalls along northbound I-680 between Gebhart Avenue and Mueller Avenue
- Construct new soundwalls along southbound I-680 between Alum Rock Avenue and Foss Avenue

Project Cost Estimate

Total project cost is estimated at \$5.6 million.

Project Schedule

- 2016 - 2018..... Project Approval/Environmental Studies
- 2018 - 2019..... Design and Engineering
- 2019..... Begin Construction
- 2020..... Complete Construction
