What will VTA be doing for our elementary school students and their caretakers at the crosswalks near this station?	We're still determining details for pedestrian access. We will add this as an action item and will update you when we have more information.
VTA buses drive really fast on Santa Clara Street. I was giving a tour to a graduate student recently, and we saw a speeding bus run a red light.	VTA Community Outreach and Public Engagement staff are present tonight and will pass along this information to the appropriate staff. Anyone witnessing similar behaviors can submit feedback on VTA's website (link below), and Customer Service will create a ticket.
