

- Gather feedback on what the environmental scope of the project should be in preparation for the Draft EIR/EA.





















B BROKAW ROAD OFF-RAMP QUEUE EXTENDS TO FREEWAY














Project Purpose and Need


- Enhance transportation network within the project area to accommodate planned growth as anticipated under the adopted *Envision San José 2040 General Plan*.

 International Airport.




