Will there be a short list for candidates and will CWG members be able to choose the facilitator, and be part of the interview process?	Yes, we would be open to it but have to check in with VTA's Procurement department on the process.
Phase II Updates: May Board Recap	
How accurate is the schedule given today's global situation, inflation, shortages? Is scheduling taking this into account? We should consider getting the boring machine first.	8 months were added to the tunnel and trackwork contract package mainly due to the tunnel boring, but we haven't extended out past 2030. This is in part due to what is occurring within tunnel and trackwork contract as they advance the design. They'll do an open book cost and schedule with us through progressive design build. VTA will have much more certainty with regards to schedule and cost in the next 12 -18 months. The timeline and final cost could change.
