


VTA's Role in Santa Clara County

VTA is more than buses and light rail. As the County Transportation Agency for the County, we also:

- Act as a funding conduit for local cities and other agencies
- Design and build transit facilities, highway improvements, and expand rail service
- Plan for congestion management and land-use
- Design, build and own BART to Silicon Valley infrastructure in Santa Clara County

The Valley Transportation Plan (VTP) is an important step to developing and delivering many of these projects and programs.





What is VTP?

Valley Transportation Plan 2050 (VTP) is the long-term plan for transportation, land use, transit, and bicycle and pedestrian planning.

The VTP:


- Identifies transportation projects and programs
- Prepares agencies to secure funding for these projects
- Considers all types of travel transit, bike and pedestrian, highways, local streets and roadway
- Will be included in Plan Bay Area updates


