EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- To present the bus and light rail ridership performance of the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority.

This report is routinely produced after each month. This report is for the month of May 2023.

DISCUSSION:

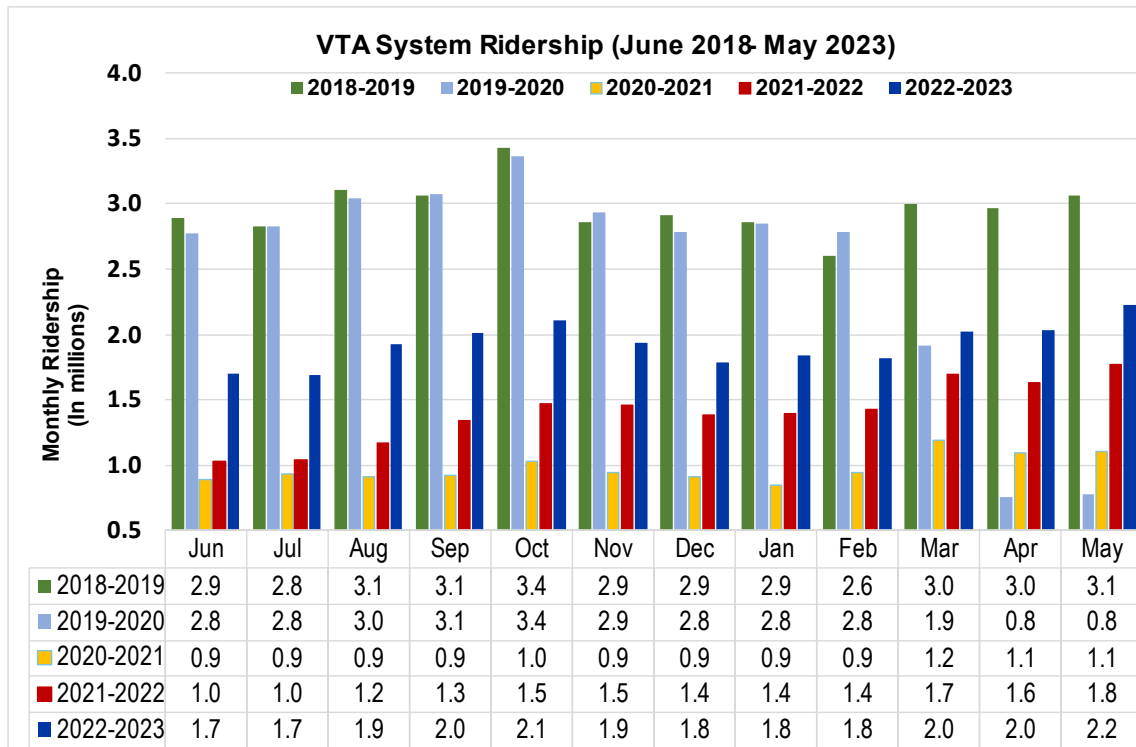
May 2023 total monthly system ridership was 2,226,371, an increase of 26.2% over May 2022. The total monthly bus ridership was 1,848,641, an increase of 25.2% over May 2022. The total monthly light rail ridership in May 2023 was 377,730, an increase of 31.0% over May 2022. May 2023 monthly system ridership increased by 9.7% compared to April 2023. The system ridership (bus and light rail) in the calendar year through May 2023 is about 31% less compared to a similar period prior to the pandemic.

There was a Levi's' event in May, the San Jose Earthquakes versus Los Angeles Football Club. About 6,476 fans rode VTA transit to the event.

The replacement of the OCS (Overhead Catenary System) along the North and South Corridor began on May 22, 2023. Bus bridges were in place to minimize impacts to the riding public.

The system ridership (Bus and light rail) in millions from June 2018 through May 2023 is presented in the chart below.



Note: Pre-pandemic data reflected in the chart for the months of June 2018 through February 2020 and a few days in March 2020. Mid-March 2020 onwards had impacts from COVID-19.

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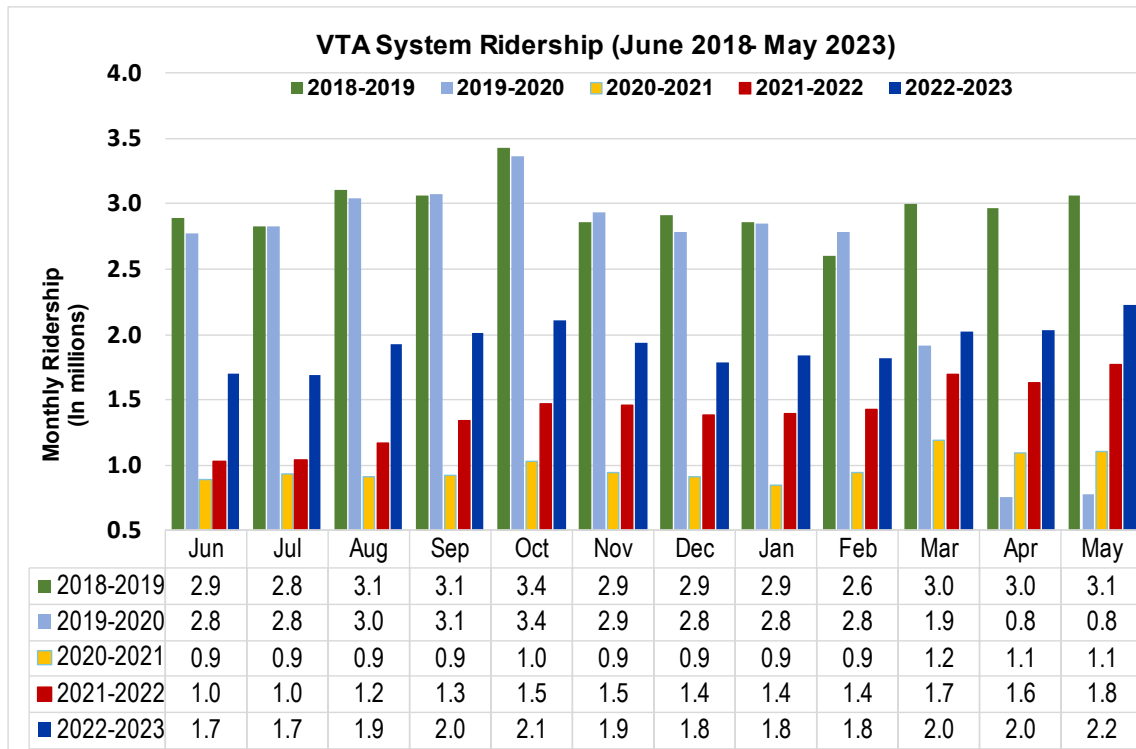
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
