- 2. Short Weaving Length between Off and On Ramps
- 3. No Southbound On-ramp
















Project Purpose

- Provide locally-scaled transportation improvements that address multiple existing deficiencies.
 - Improve access for all travel modes in the area including bicycles, pedestrians, and transit.
 - Improve safety for all travel modes in the Project area.
 - Improve mobility for all travel modes in the Project area.
 - Improve traffic operations in the Project Area as well as the local street network.




Project Need

- Accommodation for All Modes of Transportation There are currently insufficient facilities for pedestrians and bikes
- <u>Safety</u> Bike/Pedestrian Conflict with vehicles, Short Weave between Charleston On-ramp and SB Rengstorff off-ramp
- Accessibility to Local Destinations Mobility to/from local destinations is currently limited
- <u>Traffic Operations</u> Lack of SB on-ramp from San Antonio Road adds to Local Street Congestion




Project Existing Conditions – Rengstorff Ave








Project Existing Conditions - San Antonio Rd








Project Build Alternative






Rengstorff Ave - Bike/Ped Improvements
