

FACT SHEET: Highways

I-280 Soundwalls Project

Overview

The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), in cooperation with the City of San José and the Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to construct soundwalls on I-280 between State Route 87 and Los Gatos Creek.

Objectives

The purpose of this project is to reduce noise by constructing soundwalls as an effective abatement measure.

Project Features


The potential improvements, subject to meeting noise abatement criteria, will include but are not limited to the following:

- Constructing new soundwalls along northbound I-280 between the Caltrain tracks and the Los Gatos Creek Bridge
- Constructing new soundwalls along southbound I-280 between the Los Gatos Creek Bridge and the Caltrain tracks
- Constructing new soundwalls along southbound I-280
 between the Caltrain tracks and Bird Avenue
- Constructing new soundwalls along southbound I-280
 between Bird Avenue and State Route 87

Project Schedule

Funding Category	Schedule
Environmental Clearance Phase	May 2020 – Spring 2022
Design Phase	Spring 2022 – Summer 2025
Construction Phase	Fall 2025 – Summer 2026

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Project Cost Estimate

The total project cost is estimated at \$14.5 million and may be funded with a combination of local and state funds.
