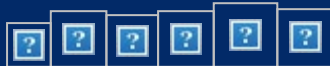

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

To present the bus and light rail ridership performance of the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority.

STRATEGIC PLAN/GOALS:

The report is an information item only.

BACKGROUND:

This report is routinely produced after each month. This report is for the month of July 2025.

CLIMATE IMPACT:

The report is an information item and will have no impact on climate change.

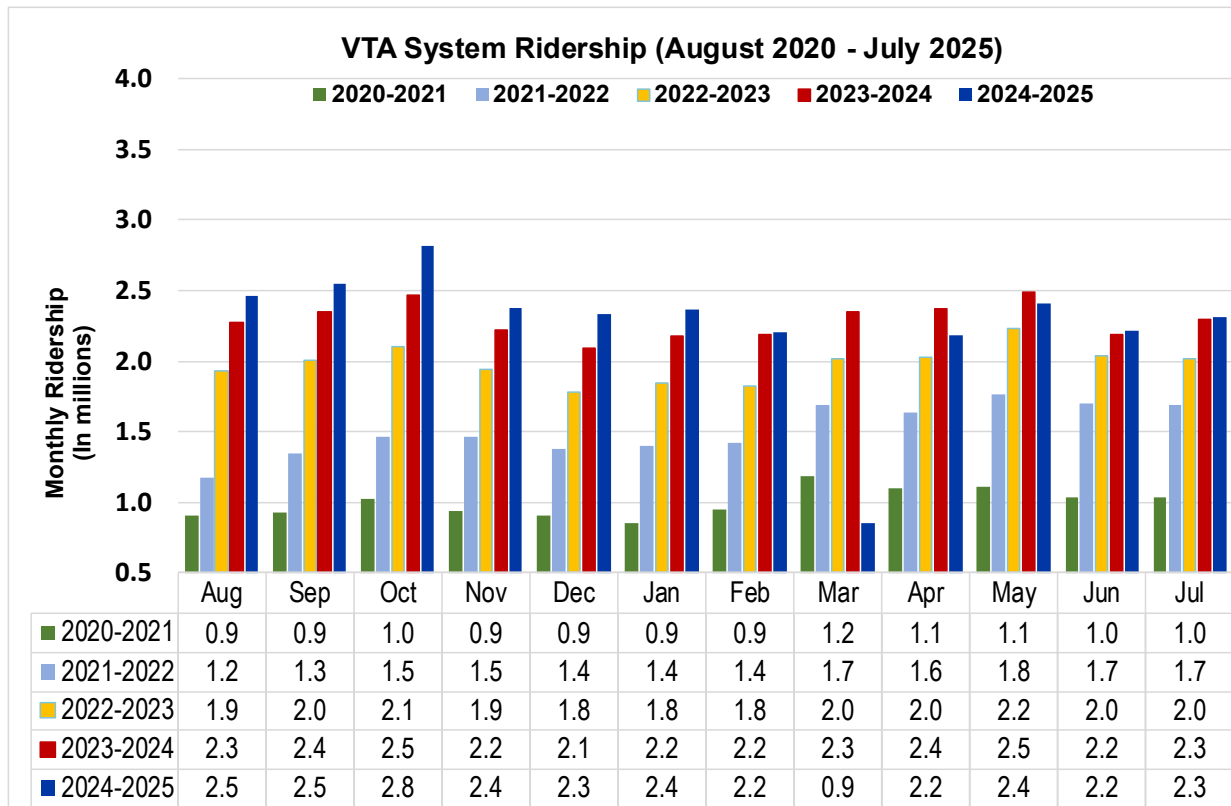
DISCUSSION:

July 2025 total monthly system ridership was 2,314,492, an increase of nearly 1.0% compared to July 2024. The total monthly bus ridership was 1,892,423, an increase of 0.4% compared to July 2024. The total monthly light rail ridership was 422,069, an increase of 3.1% compared to July 2024. The average weekday system ridership for July 2025 increased by 1.3%. The Calendar year-to-date (January 2025 through July 2025) system ridership (bus and light rail) was 14,538,728, a decrease of 9.4% compared to same period last year. March 2025 had service disruptions for majority of the month causing overall decrease in the year-to-date totals. During July, light rail service was impacted by Rail Rehabilitation work in the area surrounding the intersection of Capitol/McKee. Bus bridges were in place to supplement service.

Levi's Events: There was a CONCACAF Gold Cup soccer game and The Weeknd performed twice at Levi's Stadium in July 2025. The average ridership from the three events recorded about 12,825 riders.

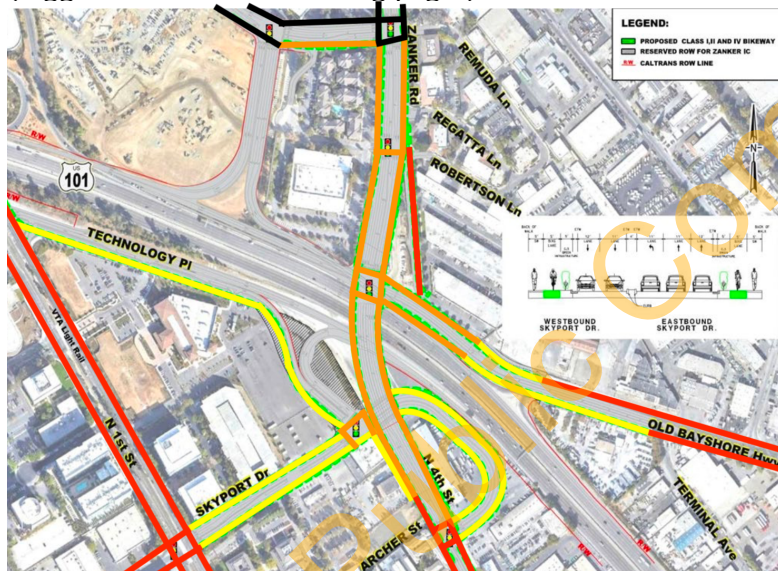

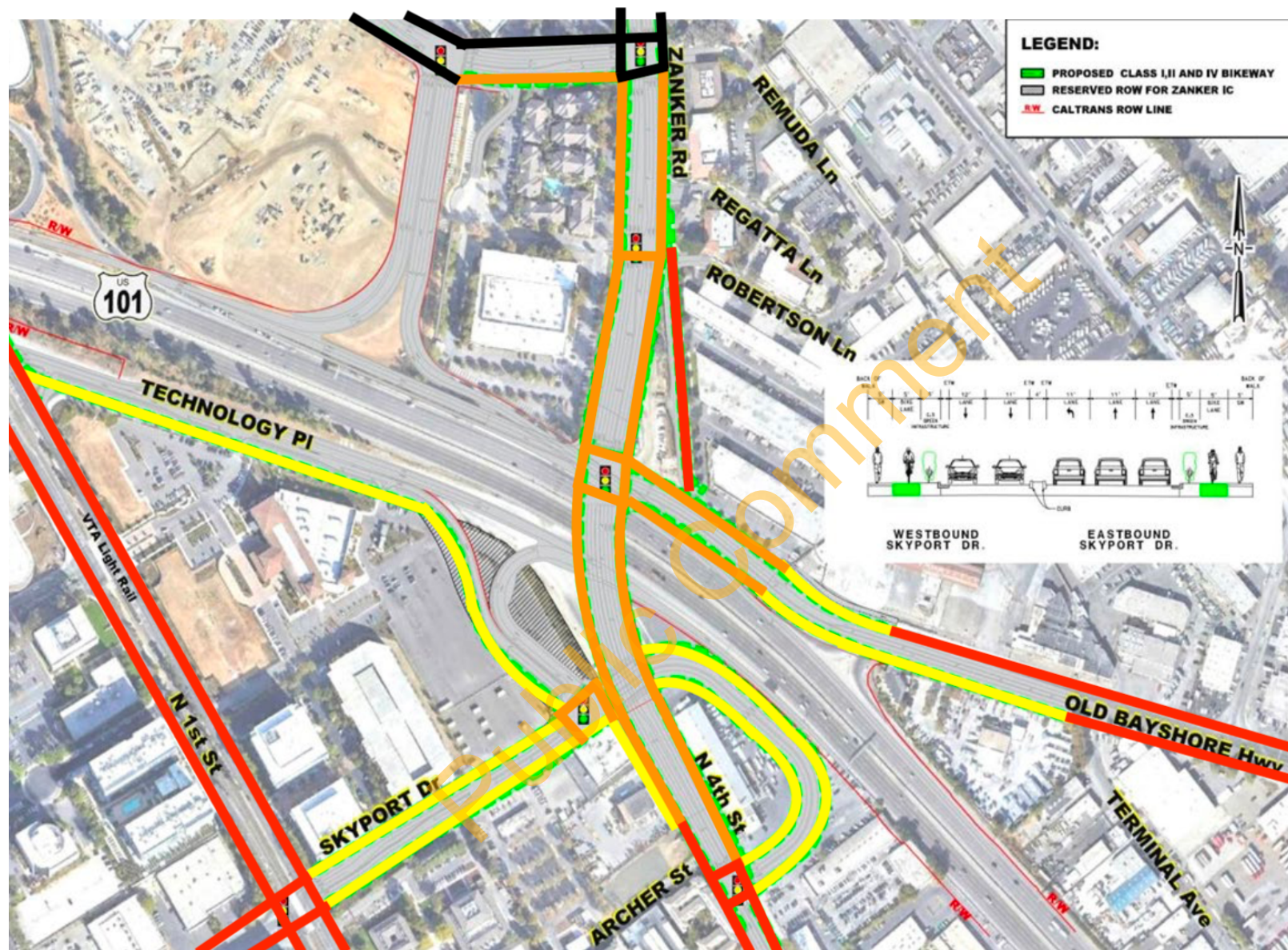
Honorable Board members,

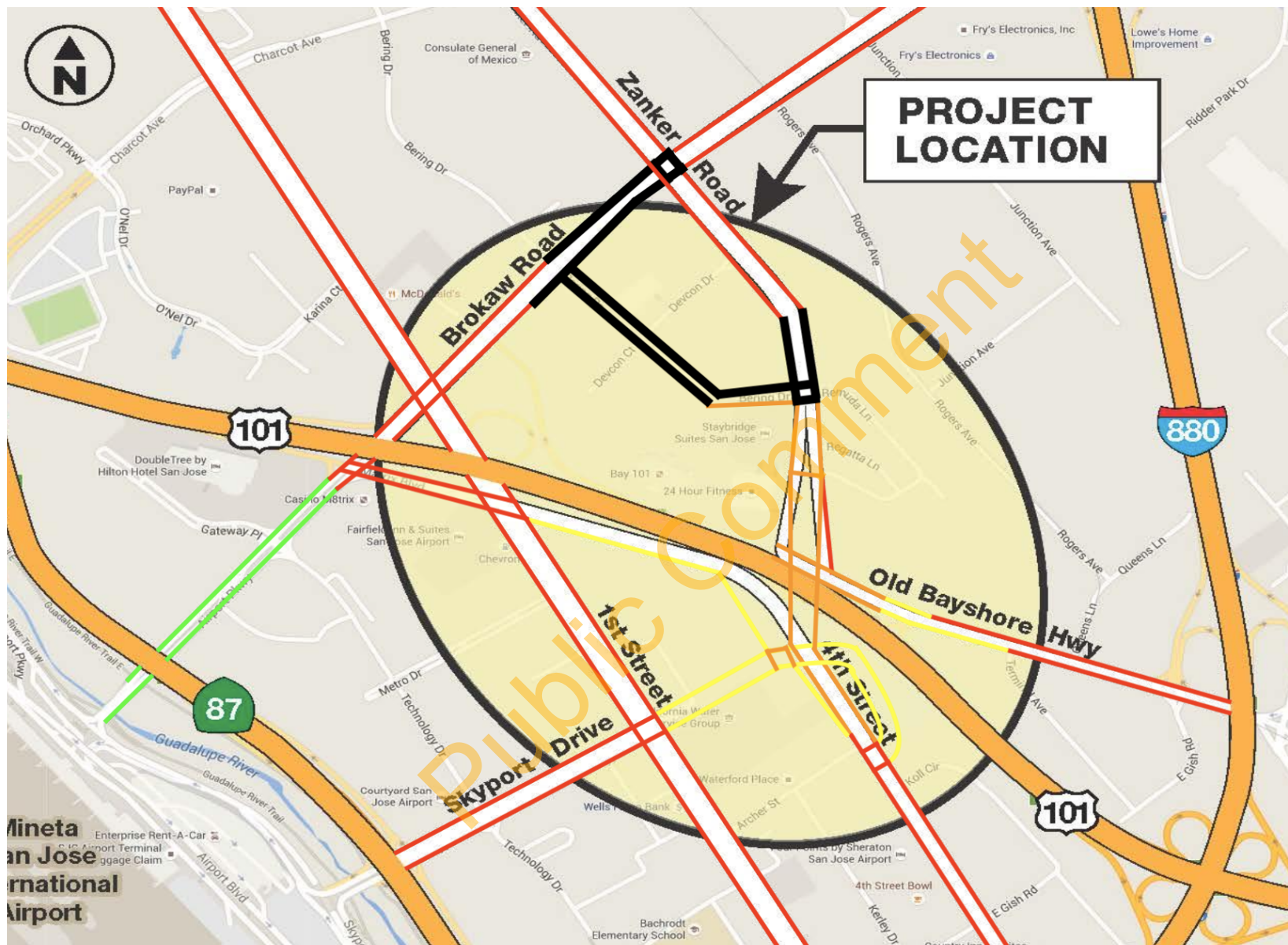
In your packet for this item, Attachments B and C have maps of proposed bicycle and pedestrian improvements. These maps do not tell the full story, as they lump all bicycle infrastructure into one category. The below images have been annotated to show what I see when I research the details of the project. Color key:

- Green – Existing Class IV separated bikeway, outside of the project area.
- Yellow – Project-proposed separated bikeway, using minimum-width dimensions of 5 or 6 feet.
- Orange – The same as yellow, indicating a segment that has 3+ through lanes in each direction.
- Red – Existing Class II constrained (un-buffered) bike lane, project-proposed constrained bike lane, or missing bike lane on a street that requires a separated bikeway in order to be an All Ages and Abilities (AA&A) bikeway.
- Black – The same as red, indicating a segment with a project-proposed widening to add additional lanes for cars, without creating the separated bikeways required to keep users safe.

As you can see, none of the bikeways in this project are best-in-class, AA&A bikeways. In many cases, VTA wishes to acquire additional Right-of-Way for the purpose of adding more than twenty feet of additional car lane width, while still providing minimum-width bikeways, sometimes without any protection. This is unacceptable. It also casts additional doubt on the unapproved Draft EIR, which makes the already-dubious claims that this project will reduce vehicle miles traveled.

For this project to meet VTA's values, goals, and climate targets, this project must be fundamentally changed, before entering final design:

- All bikeways and intersections should be All Ages and Abilities (AA&A) facilities.
- Increase the widths of all bikeways to their maximum desirable widths, according to NACTO standards.
- Install Class IV protected bikeways (using quick-build materials if necessary) on every major street segment that the project will be working on.
- In particular, part of the justification for this project is enabling safer bike travel under US-101, on N 1st St. This should be a commitment that this project delivers, not a potential future benefit.
- Use four through lanes for cars, not six. Extra width should only be added if it is for the purpose of adding transit-only right-of-way.

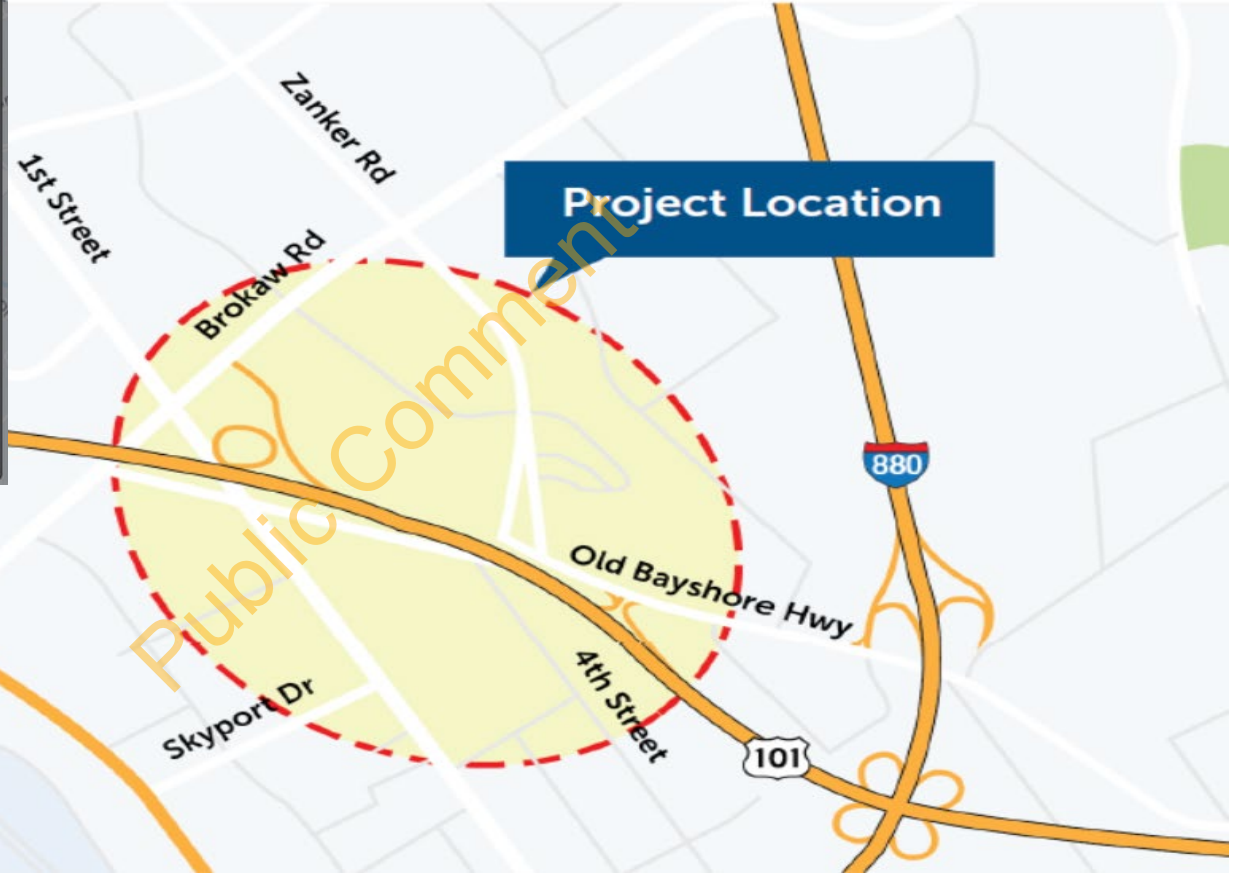
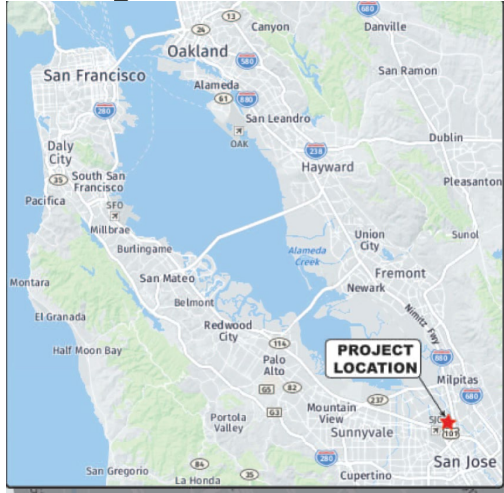

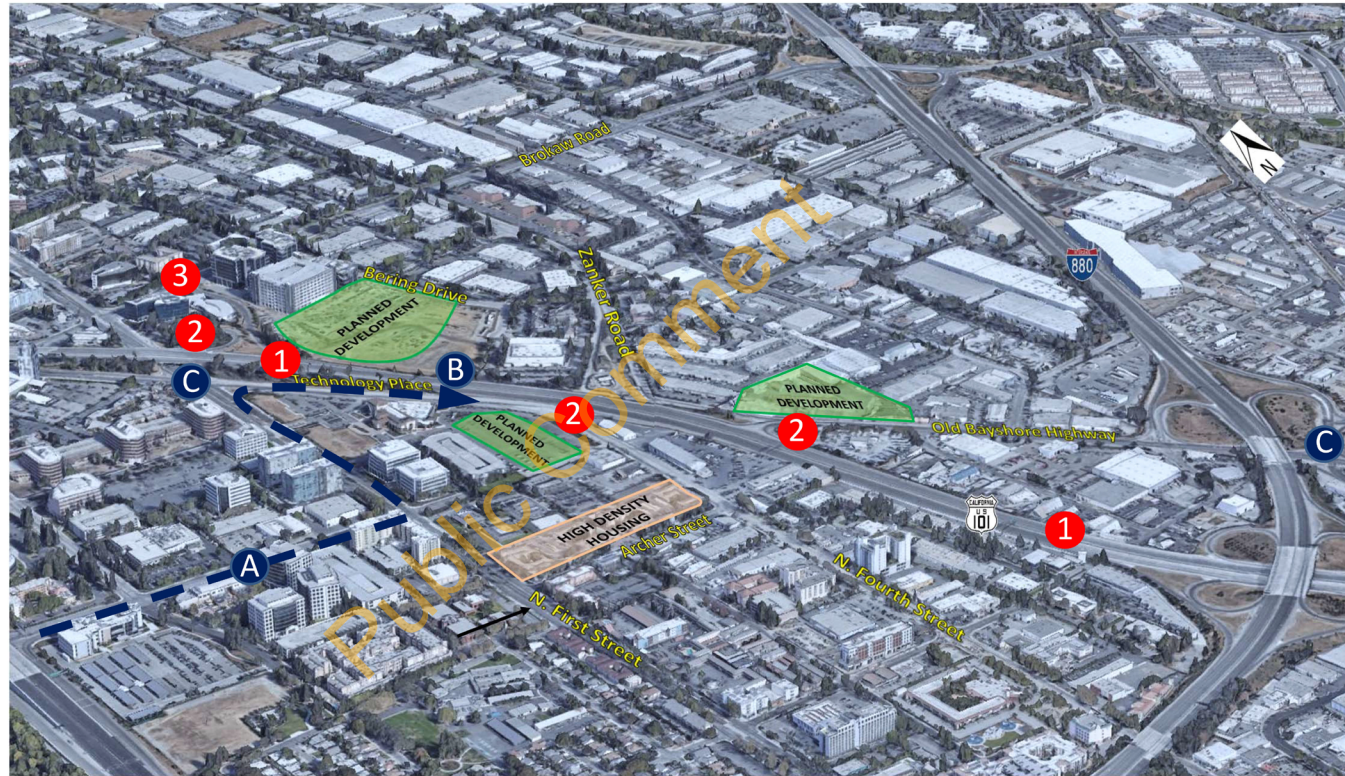
Project Location



Project Purpose and Need

- Enhance transportation network in the Project area to accommodate planned growth as anticipated under the adopted Envision San José 2040 General Plan.
- Improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities in the Project area.
- Improve safety and traffic operations at the on- and off-ramps and mainline of US 101 within the Project limits.
- Improve access to/from the San José Mineta International Airport (SJIA).

Project Deficiencies

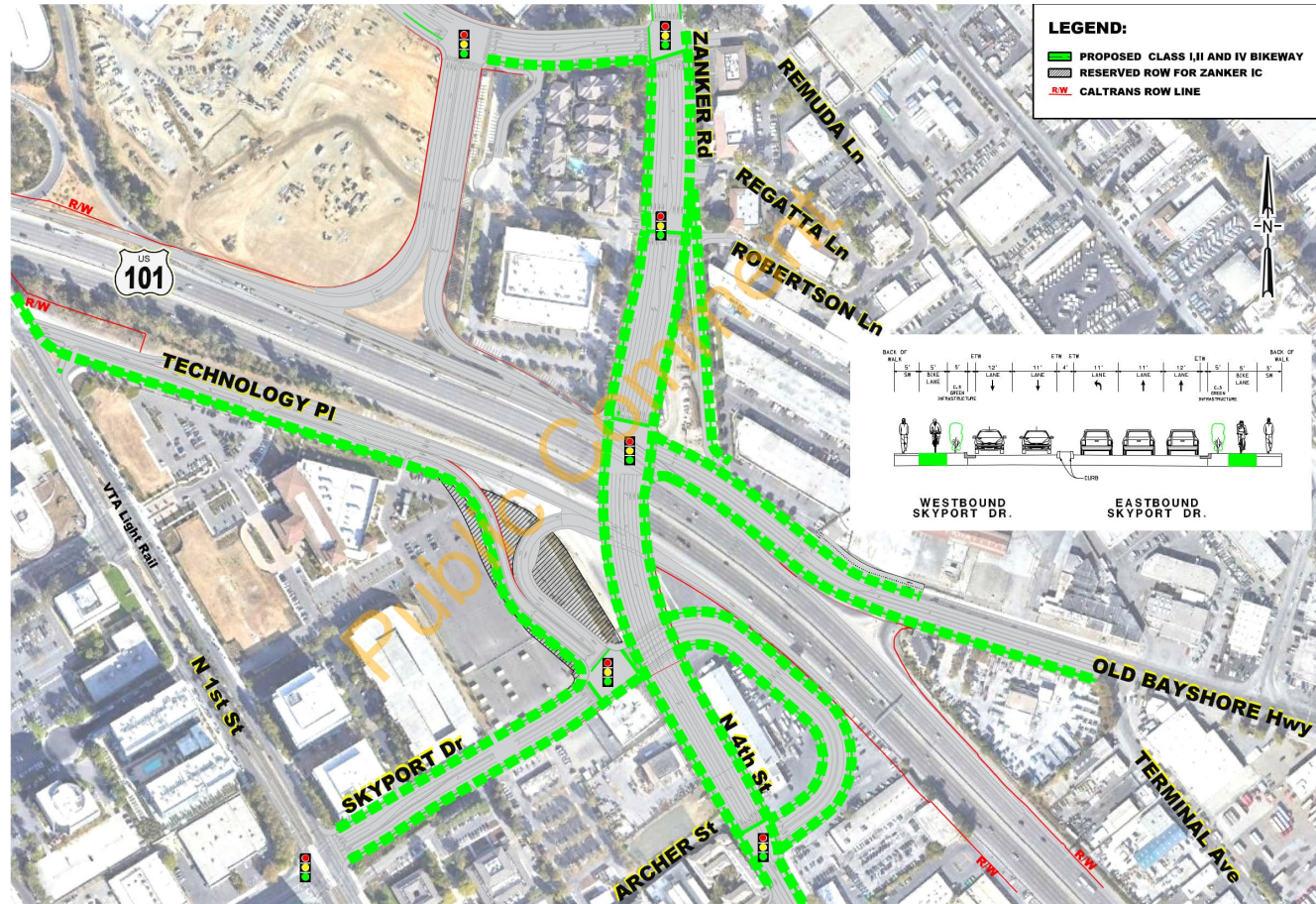
Active Transportation Needs – Current Facilities

- Project area identified as Across Barrier Connections (ABC) deficiency in the 2008 Countywide Bicycle Plan; Tenth Street and North First Street are the only routes that bicyclists and pedestrians can use to cross US 101. Between these two streets (a distance of 1.25 miles), there are no other crossing of US 101.
- Sidewalks are lacking on segments of Skyport Drive, Technology Place, Old Bayshore Highway, Zanker Road, Fourth Street, and Brokaw Road.

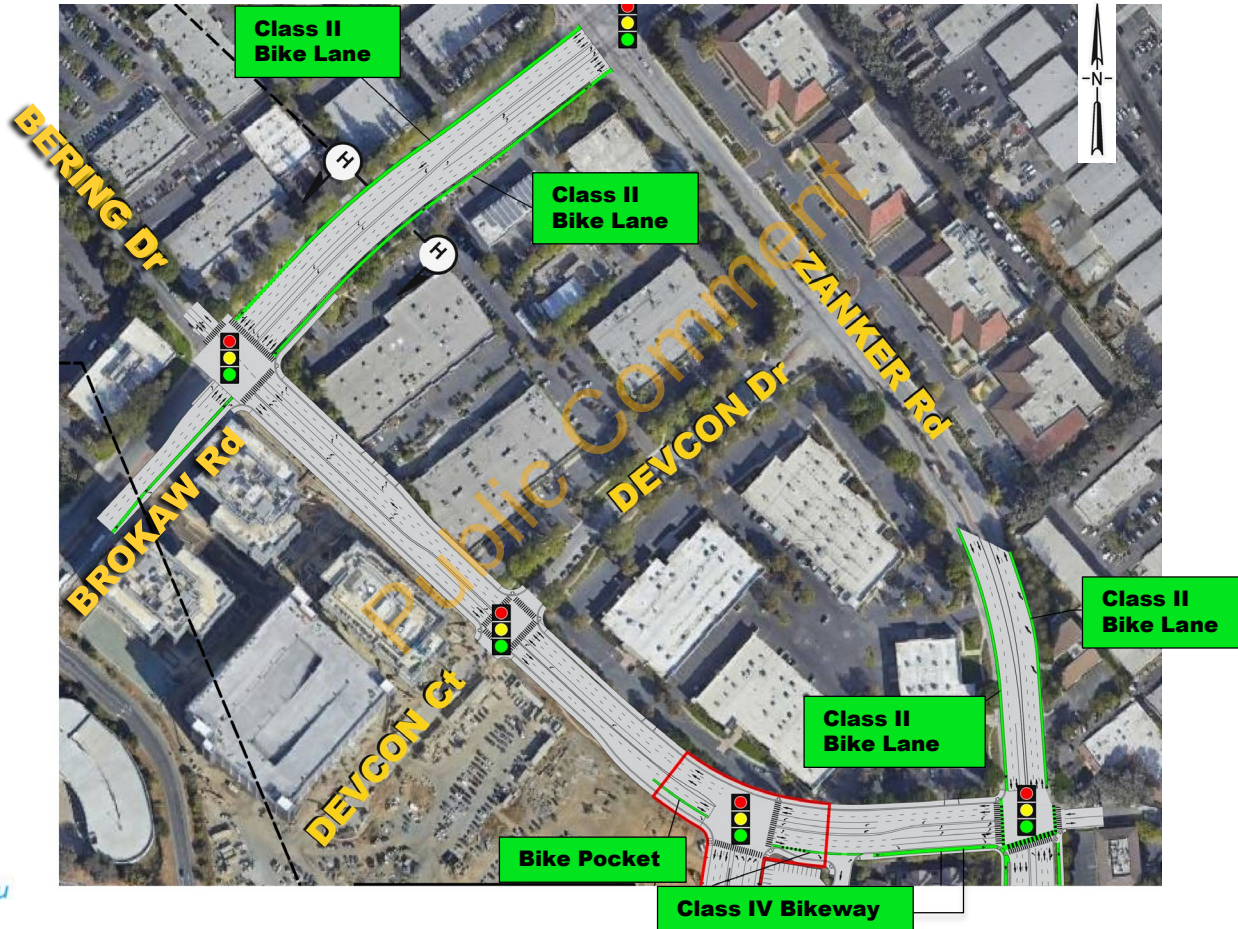
Proposed Project – Bicycle and Pedestrian

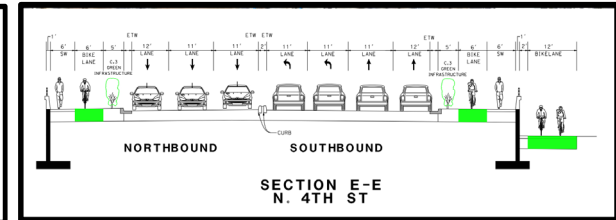

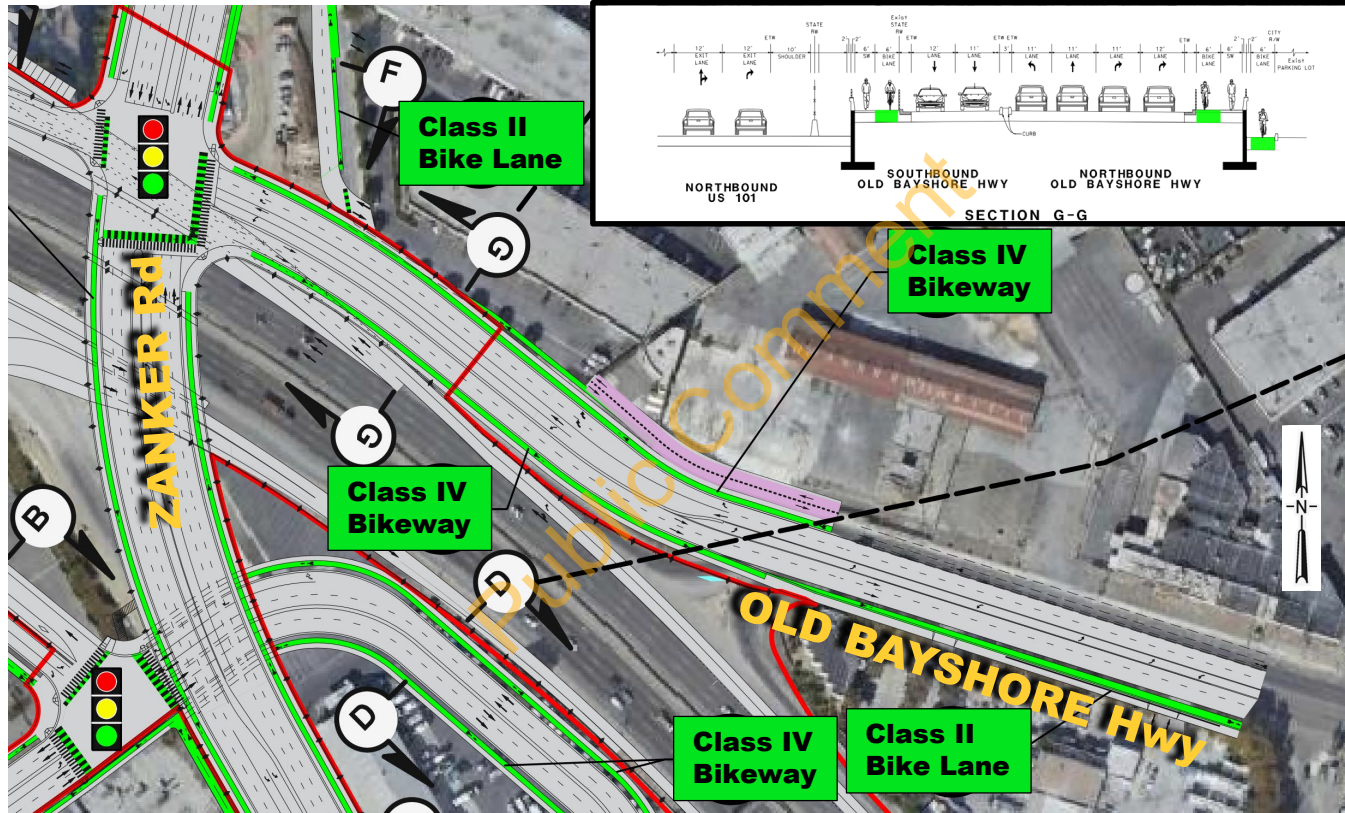
This aerial map illustrates the proposed bicycle infrastructure for the Zanker Rd and Berling Dr area in San Jose, CA. The map shows the following streets and infrastructure details:

- N 4th St:** Features a Class II Bike Lane on the north side.

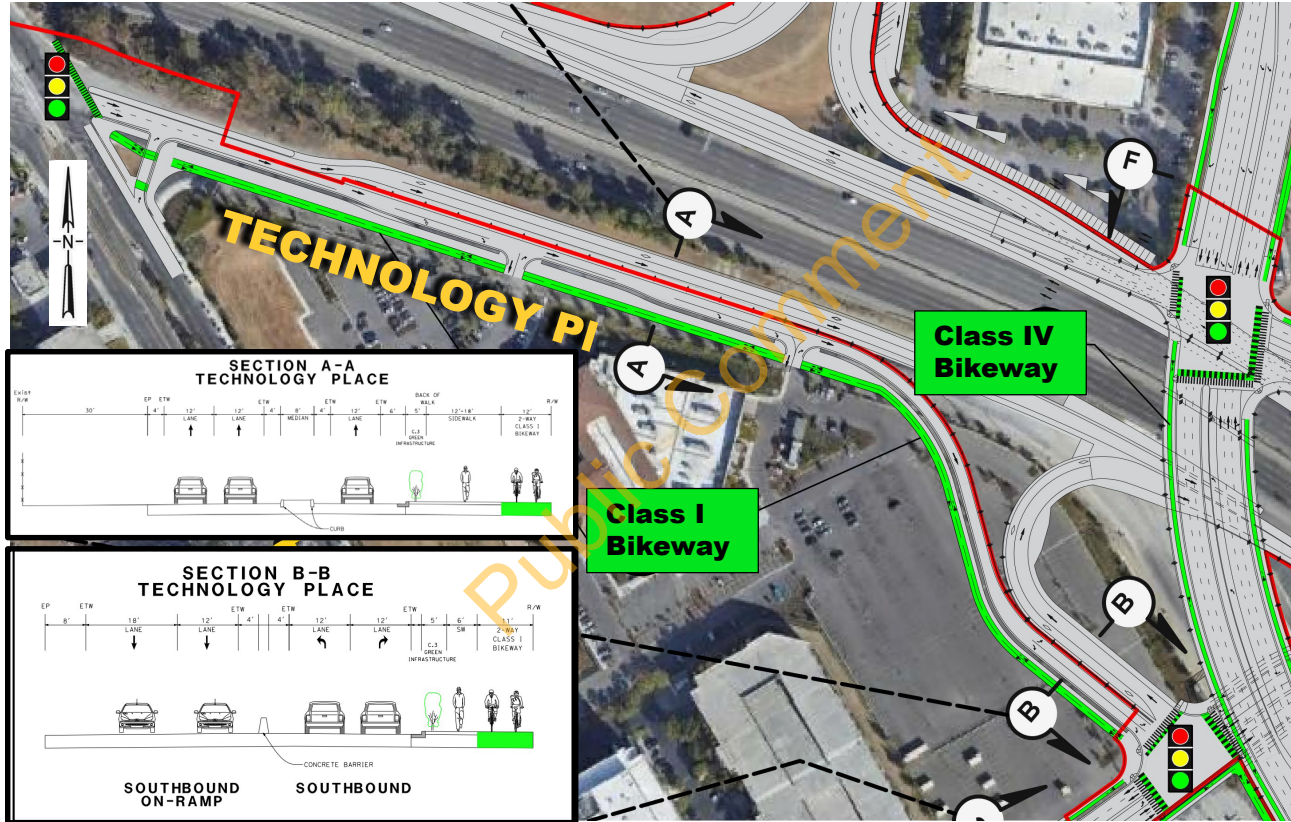

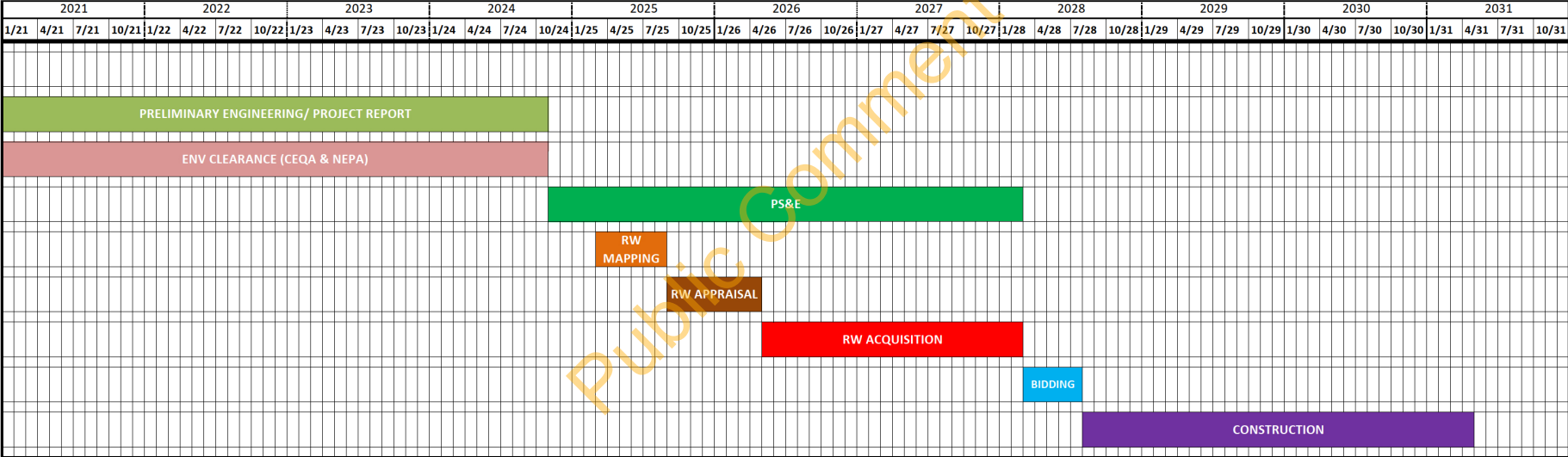
