Work Gets Underway to Relieve Traffic on Crowded Cupertino Freeway Interchange

San Jose, CA - With support from Apple Inc., the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority is launching construction to ease congestion at the busy I-280 and Wolfe Road interchange in the Cupertino, improving access near Apple Park while creating safer routes for pedestrians and cyclists.

A groundbreaking ceremony is scheduled for **Tuesday, April 28, 2026, at 10:30 a.m. at 10380 Perimeter Road in Cupertino**, and media are invited to attend.

The project, funded largely through voter-approved **2016 Measure B sales tax revenues**, includes a new Wolfe Road overpass, updated on- and off-ramps at Interstate 280, modifications to nearby intersections, and upgraded bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

The City of Cupertino is contributing to the \$124 million interchange project, **including securing \$4 million through a grant amendment with Apple to close a funding gap** and advance bridge reconstruction, multimodal upgrades, and congestion relief in the area.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is a key partner, supporting environmental compliance, design approvals, and integration with the highway system.

The Santa Clara County Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) is pleased to invite proposals for the 2026 Transit-Oriented Communities (TOC) Grant Program, with \$750,000 in total funding available for eligible organizations.

These grants advance VTA's vision of creating TOCs around transit stations by growing ridership, expanding social and economic opportunity, and addressing regional priorities.

This year's program expands eligibility to include VTA's Frequent Bus corridors, opening the grant to a broader range of neighborhoods across Santa Clara County.

Public agencies, charities, universities, cultural institutions, neighborhood associations, environmental groups, and other nonprofit organizations are encouraged to apply.
