



FACT SHEET: EPD Transit Safety

Pedestrian Crosswalk at Eastridge Transit Center

Overview

The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) proposes to construct a pedestrian crosswalk connecting the Eastridge Transit Center and Eastridge Mall, as well as minor access improvements to the VTA operators' facility.

Objectives

When complete, this project will:

1. Improve pedestrian safety along the route from Eastridge Transit Center to the Eastridge Mall.
2. Improve safe movement paths for VTA bus operators within transit center

Project Features

This project will include construction of sidewalk and curb ramps, crosswalks, Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons, and upgrade of signs and pavement markings.

Project Schedule

Construction August 2026 - January 2027

Project Cost Estimate/ Project Funding

The total project cost is estimated at \$1.05 million and is funded by a combination of local funds.
