



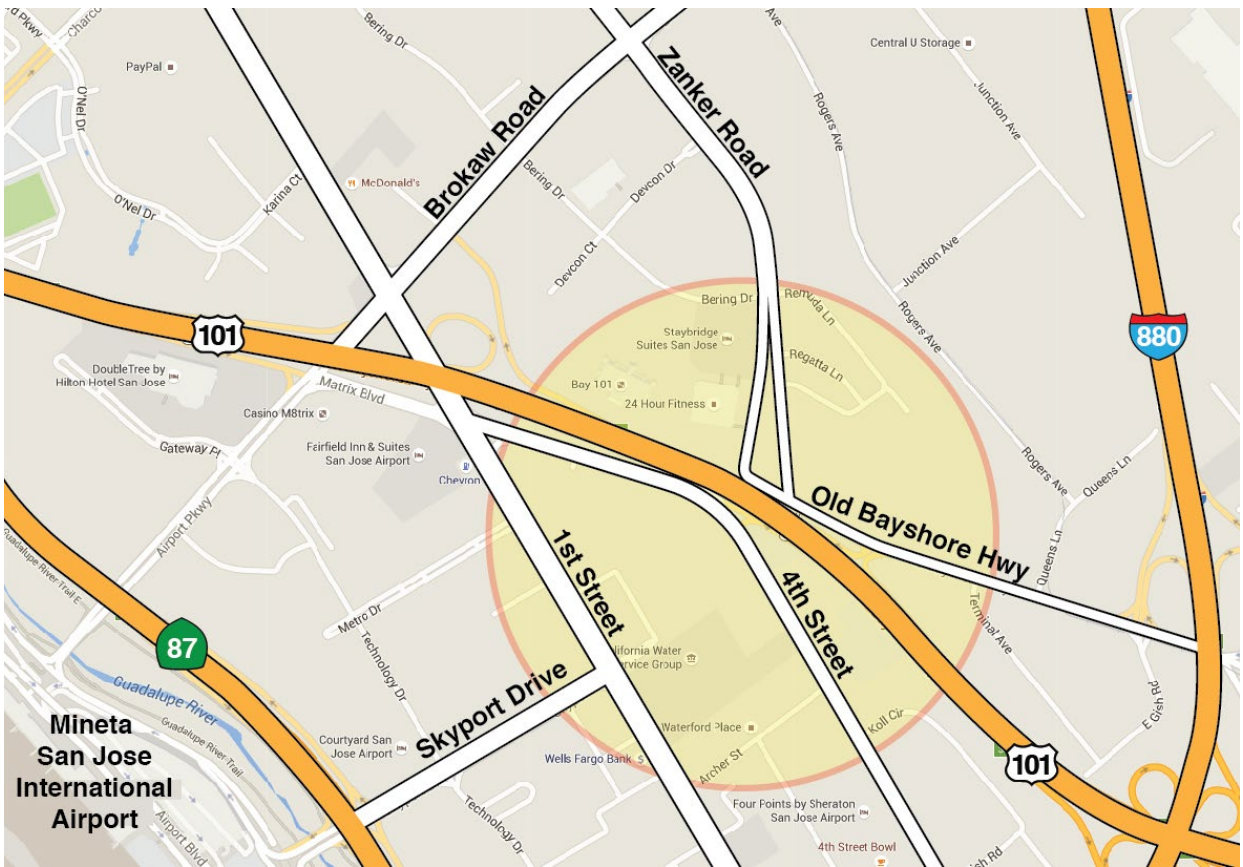
FACT SHEET: *Highways*

US 101/Zanker Road Improvement Project

Overview

Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), in cooperation with the City of San Jose and California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to improve traffic operations and relieve congestion to support the North San Jose (NSJ) development area in the vicinity of Highway 101 (US 101), Zanker Road, Skyport Drive and North 4th Street between the US 101/North 1st Street and US 101/I-880 interchanges in San Jose.

Objectives

The purpose of this project is to improve traffic efficiency, local network circulation and accommodate multiple modes of travel with a new north-south local road corridor (parallel to North First Street corridor) by constructing a new overcrossing to connect Zanker Road to Skyport Drive/North 4th Street. This project will improve access to and from the Mineta San Jose International Airport (SJC), provide new pedestrian and bicycle facilities, and enhance transportation services within the NSJ development area.

The proposed improvements include, but are not limited to the following:

- Construct a new bridge overcrossing at US 101/Zanker Road/Skyport Drive/North 4th Street
- Modify or consolidate existing US 101 on- and off-ramps
- Modify existing local street connections and intersections in the area
- Implement Complete Street improvements

Project Schedule

The Alternative Study and Project Initiation Document (PID) were approved by Caltrans in July 2017.
