Not-For-Profit Pass

Institutions qualify for the Not-For-Profit SmartPass under one of the following categories:

- 1. Nonprofit** – An organization granted nonprofit status under state and federal tax exemptions which may also include not-for profit schools.
- 2. Low-Income Housing** – Generally refers to properties required to provide units at below-market rents that are subsidized or discounted based on the tenant's income, unlike Market Rate Housing where rents are set by the landlord and based on how much the unit is worth on the market. Examples of low-income housing include Low-Income Housing, Subsidized Housing and Senior Housing.
- 3. Government Agency** – A local, state or federal administrative unit of the United States government.

Important: Excluding Government Agencies, participating Institutions are required to provide an IRS Exemption Determination Letter to verify Not-For-Profit status. A residential community or development shall have a minimum 25 units to join the program.

SmartPass Service Levels

VTA offers two types of SmartPasses:

- A. Standard SmartPass:** grants access to unlimited trips on all VTA-operated bus and light rail service, **excluding** VTA Express Bus service*; and
- B. Express SmartPass:** grants access to all VTA-operated bus and light rail service in addition to VTA Express Bus service, Dumbarton Express, Highway 17 Express and Monterey-Salinas Transit Express services.

* Note: Standard SmartPass holders will receive a discount of \$2.50 on the regularly priced \$5.00 VTA Express Bus Adult Single Ride fare. Prior to boarding, riders must load E-cash value on to their SmartPass Clipper card in order to pay this Express Bus surcharge.

Annual SmartPass Rates

The per-person annual Not-For-Profit SmartPass rates shown below are based on: (1) the VTA service available at the site's geographic location, (2) the quantity of passes for the entire eligible population(s) the Institution must purchase, and (3) the type of SmartPass (Standard or Express). A minimum annual charge of \$2,500 shall apply to all SmartPass contracts.
