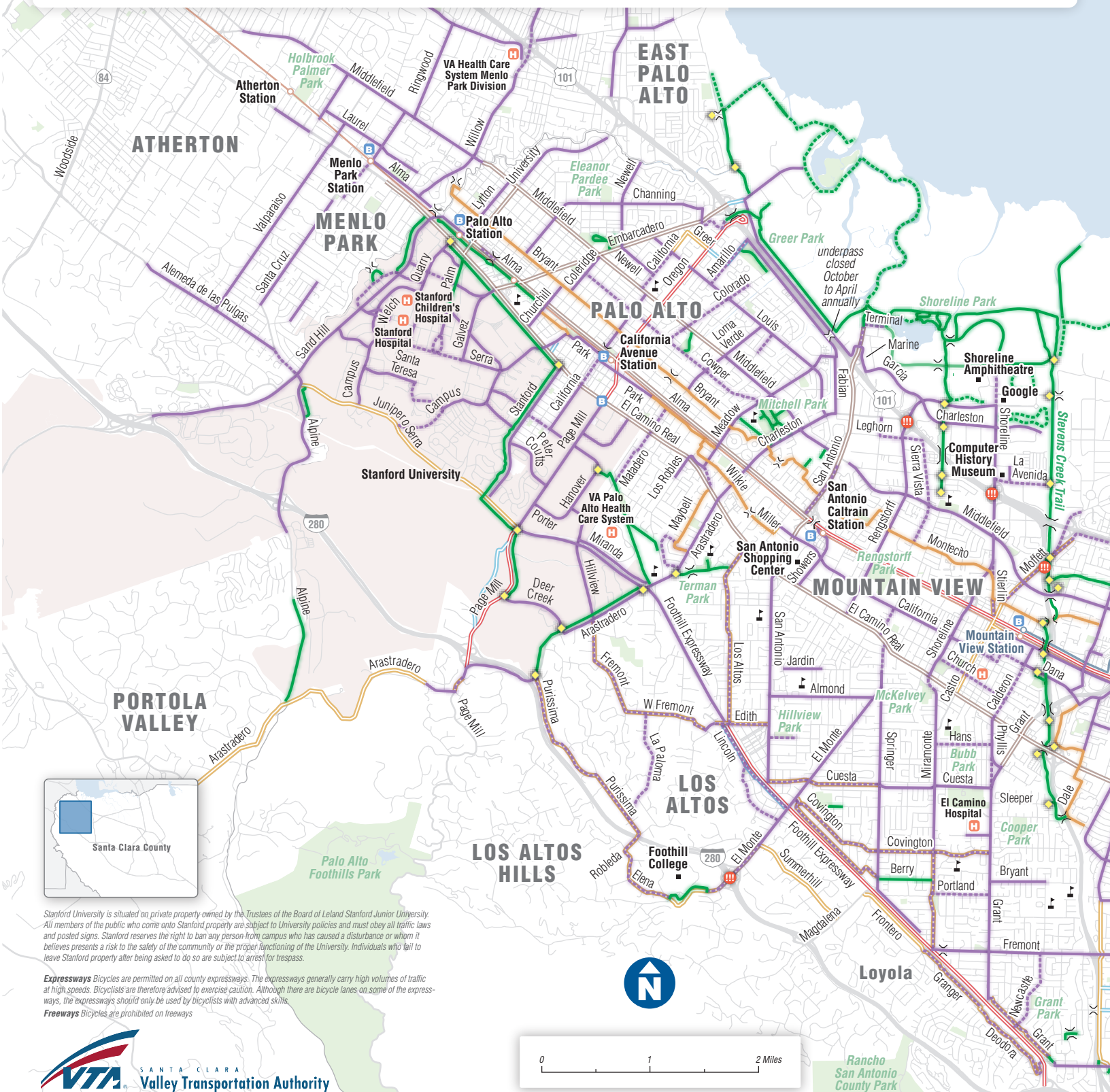


Santa Clara Valley **BIKEWAYS MAP** Palo Alto & Mountain View Area

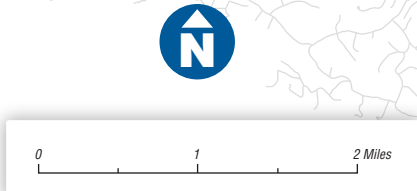

Although there are bicycle lanes on some of the expressways, the expressways should only be used by bicyclists with advanced skills.
