



Project Introduction Fact Sheet

Tasman Drive and Great Mall Parkway serve a wide cross-section of auto, light rail, bus, bike, and pedestrian trips. With many current and planned activity centers along the corridor (Levi's Stadium, Great Mall, Cisco and Samsung offices, major residential developments, CityPlace, Milpitas BART Station, among others), the transportation demands on the corridor are continuing to grow. In order to provide for that growth in a sustainable and community-supportive manner, this project seeks to enhance the safety, comfort, and reliability of the corridor's transit, bicycle, and pedestrian facilities, while still accommodating drivers.


Project Objective:


