<b>Construction Outreach Best Practices</b>	
In Los Angeles, <sup>3</sup> ⁄ <sub>4</sub> of projects are funded by sales tax, don't they hit a cap?	Their taxes are exempt per state law.
Many cities are competing for a percent of sales tax. Will BART be o.k.?	Yes, with what is going in June, if they pass there is still room for a ½ cent tax for BART.
