The following pages contain responses to questions submitted by prospective Proposers. Do not submit the attached "Q&A" document in your proposal.

- Q1. Is the Stokes crossing the only location that currently has the desired pedestrian gate layout?
- A1. Two of the four quadrants at Leigh Avenue crossing have a similar layout.
- Q2. Will the winning proposer have access to the designs for the locations with the desired pedestrian gate layout?
- A2. The designs for the current locations with the desired layout will be made available to the winning proposer.
- Q3. Does VTA have plans to double-track affected locations?
- A3. VTA does not have plans to double-track affected locations.
- Q4. Is the design separate from the build?
- A4. Yes, design is separate from build.
- Q5. What is VTA's definition of "local preference"?
- A5. Additional information regarding local preference can be found on Form 7. Local Firm Certification, page 29 of the RFP.
- Q6. Could you confirm the Work Schedule tentative starting date of October 2019 on page 20 of the RFP?
- A6. The tentative starting date has been revised. Please see Addendum No. 1.



- Q7. Can VTA share the cost estimate for the project?
- A7. VTA does not disclose cost estimate information.
- Q8. Does VTA intend to include the 10 identified at-grade street crossings within 1 bid package, or have each crossing location be a separate bid package?
- A8. VTA intends to issue one (1) bid package with all crossing locations, plus the Mountain View location specified in the RFP.
- Q9. Please confirm Form 8 (Certification of Restrictions on Lobbying) and Form 9 (Certificate of Consultant) apply solely to Prime Consultants.
- A9. Form 8 and Form 9 applies to both Prime and Subcontractors.
