



## Silicon Valley Express Lanes Program

- Phase 1 in operation since 2012
- Phase 2 under construction with opening in Nov 2019
- Phase 3 under construction with opening in Fall 2021
- Phase 4 in final design with construction in early 2021 (pending funding)
- Phase 5 project under this RFP





## **Project Overview**

- Project limits from near SR 237 in Sunnyvale to I-880 in San Jose (conform to Phase 3 project)
- Conversion of HOV lanes to express lanes and addition of second express lane in each direction from Fair Oaks Avenue to I-880
- Addition of an auxiliary lane on NB US 101 between Lawrence Expwy and Fair Oaks Avenue
- Addition of an auxiliary lane in both directions on US 101 between Great America Parkway and Lawrence Expwy
- Widen Guadalupe River and San Tomas Aquino Creek bridges

  - Assumed No Right of Way Acquisition Necessary
- 35%, 65%, 95%, 100% & Final PS&E
