Q6. In a previous bid (M18205), Section 1.5 stated that the license requirement was a C-27 and D-49. Then, Addendum #1 was issued stating that the contractor must possess only a C-27. Given that the same license requirement for M19135 is stated in Section 1.5, can the license requirement be amended to possess a C-27 only in this case as well? I've attached a copy of Addendum #1 from M18205 for your reference.

Also, we reached out to CLCA to inquire about the C-27 and D-49 license classifications and I've attached an email that has supporting documentation that, in short, means a C-27 can legally oversee and do the work under a D-49 classification.

Based on this, we're asking if the license requirement can be amended to a C-27 only?

A6. According to California Contractors State License Board (CSLB) it is acceptable for a C27-Landscaping contractor to perform all of the work that a D49-Tree Service contractor can perform. Therefore, we are issuing an addendum to remove the C-61/D-49 license requirement.
