- Section 1.4 states that "All Bids shall be enclosed in a <u>sealed</u> envelope bearing the Contract number, the title of the Project, the date and hour of the Bid opening, and the name of the Bidder."
- Section 3.11.1 states that "Bids received after the Bid Opening will not be considered. A late Bid will be returned to the Bidder unopened."

SUBMISSION OF BID

- ➤ Bring your Bid package to the Lobby of Building B.
- ➤ It is recommended that your Bid package is hand-carried.
- Make sure to date and time stamp your Bid package using the machine at the Front Lobby. Then hand your Bid package to the security guard.
- ➤ Bid Forms that are not legible will be considered Non-Responsive.







Contractual Requirements

TIME FOR PERFORMANCE

➤ The base term of the Contract is one year (Base Year) with six (1)-year options. The total term of the Contract, including all Option Years, will not exceed 7 years.

SBE GOAL

- ➤ A Small Business Enterprise ("SBE") participation goal of 1.37% has been established for this Contract.

> License Requirements



LICENSES

Contractor must, at the time of Bid Opening, possess current licenses in the following classifications issued by the California Department of Consumer Affairs, Contractors State License Board:

License: Class A, Class B or Combination of C-5 and C-39

A combination of prime Contractor and subcontractor license is acceptable only when each subcontractor's scope of work is identified in <u>Bid Form 3</u> and each subcontractor is properly licensed at the time of Bid submittal.

BID FORMS

Your Bid package must contain 10 Bid Forms.

- ➤ <u>Bid Form 1</u>: Schedule of Quantities and Prices, Contractor Information
- As per <u>Section 2.3.2</u>, the Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive Bid and responsible Bidder ("Successful Bidder"), based on the "Total Bid Price".
- The Engineer's Estimate for the Work in this contract ranges from to \$2,000,000.00 \$2,750,000.00.









BID FORMS

- > <u>Bid Form 2</u>: Bidder's Bond (Minimum 5% of the Total Bid Price)
 - Surety Company (Form must be acknowledged by a Notary)
 - Cashier's Check or Certified Check
- ➤ <u>Bid Form 3</u>: Designation of Subcontractors (0.5% of Total Bid Price or \$10,000, whichever is greater.)
- > Bid Form 4: Listing of SBE Contractor or Subcontractors
- ➤ <u>Bid Form 5</u>: Supplemental Contractor and Subcontractor Information









- ▶ <u>Bid Form 6</u>: Litigation Disclosure (Disclose litigations within the last 5 years.)
- Bid Form 7: Certificate of Bidder
 (Certify Division 5 Labor Code violation within the last 5 years.)
- Bid Form 8: Non-Collusion Declaration (Declare no collusion.)
- <u>Bid Form 9</u>: Public Contract Code Statements (Declare offences convicted of within the last 3 years.)
- ➤ <u>Bid Form 10</u>: References and Previous Experiences (Minimum Experience Requirements and References)

Insurance Requirements

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS (Appendix A)

Winning Bidder

- ➤ General Liability (GL): \$2M (including umbrella/excess liability)
 - \$2M must be the GL primary policy limit per occurrence.
- > Automobile Liability (AL): \$2M (including umbrella/excess liability)
 - \$2M must be the Automobile Liability primary policy limit per occurrence.
- Workers' Compensation: \$1M per accident.
- Railroad Protective Liability: \$2M
- > Builder's Risk Insurance: Contractor must procure and maintain at its own expense Builder's Risk insurance.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

(Appendix A)

> Insurance Certificate

- In the "<u>Description of Operations</u>" box, you must refer to the Contract No. M20076 and the Project Title "Roofing Maintenance at Chaboya Building A".
- Must include copies of all endorsements required in Appendix A.
- Must disclose all deductibles or self-insured retentions.
- Deductibles greater than \$50K must be declared to and approved by VTA (Must submit the current financial statement the ability to pay claims.)
- Any exceptions to Appendix A must be submitted with IFB response.
- The renewal certificates must be submitted to VTA within ten (10) business days from the expiration of insurance.

CONTRACT COMPLIANCE

B: SC 6.13: SOUND CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

- Contractor must comply with all local sound control and noise level rules, regulations and ordinance applicable to any of the work.
- Noise level from Contractors operation between 9:00 PM and 6:00 AM shall not exceed 86 dbA at a distance of 50 feet.

C: SC 6.15: SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Assign competent work site safety personnel
- Submit Site Specific Work Plan
- Comply with State, Federal and local regulations regarding safety
- Submit Injury and Illness Prevention Plan (IIPP)

D: <u>SC 6.26 : ENVIRONMENTAL COORDINATION AND</u> COOPERATION

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

For purposes of this Contract, Work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, services, supervision, and incidentals necessary to perform roofing repair and replacement services at the designated Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority Facilities including but not limited to biennial roofing maintenance, re-roofing designated buildings, emergency leak repairs, ceramic tile and flashing repairs, skylight repair or replacements, gutter repair and replacements, single-ply roofing repairs and modifications.

The Work will be conducted within, among other locations, an operating rail yard and adjacent to and within existing shop facilities. This Work will be subject to restrictions to ensure safety and the continuing operations of the yard and shop and the light rail system.
