**SUBJECT**: Set #1 - Contract M20076 – Roofing Maintenance Services

- Q1. Our company specializes in commercial, government and industrial roofing, waterproofing and sheet metal services. We also hold numerous DBE state certifications that help our clients meet their set-aside goals. What we do not have is the Class A (General Engineering) or Class B (General Building) or C-5 Framing and Rough Carpentry. We do have our C-39 and C-43 licenses, and confirming the scope is well within our capacity. Will we be able to qualify to bid because we are confident in our capacity to execute the scope of work, well within our licensing and certifications.
- A1. The contract license requirement (Section 1.5) is very clear on what type of license the bidder must possess to qualify and bid on the job. It also says combination of C-5 Framing and Rough Carpentry and C-39 Roofing Contractor, if there is no Class A or B. Furthermore, bidder may fulfill these license requirements in conjunction with license held by subcontractors of any tier.
