This document provides answers to the following questions submitted regarding this solicitation:

Question 1: Can I get the winning bid for the Bus Coach Batteries from last time?

Answer 1: Previous Contract P14658 pricing

Question 2:	Line Item 2 – 8D side terminal We would like to know the exact thread size required for both positive and negative posts.			
Answer 2:	All studs, for the 8D batteries and the Group 31 batteries, are to be 3/8-16.			
Question 3:	Section 3.4 – Battery Approval process. Please provide the approval process for submitting an approved equal battery.			
Answer 3:	The requirement is that the two SAE tests specified be performed side by side in the same lab on the approved equal battery design being requested, and on an already approved battery design of the same size. If the requested approved equal has equal or better results when tested to failure as the already approved battery, on both tests, it will be approved. The sample size is not specified by SAE, therefore for the purposes of this scope it must be a minimum sample of 5 each.			
Question 4:	 Section 8 Price: It's the VTA's desire to have a fixed price contract. How can we address the following within the contract? A. California Battery Fee. Currently set at \$1.00. This will increase to \$2.00 2020. B. Any future state or federal mandated labor increase C. Any future state or federal mandated hazardous material handling fees D. Any future mandated tariffs increase that could affect the price to product the product 			
	E. Any future mandated energy cost that could affect the price to produce or deliver the product.
